

10 listed criminals arrested, 33 firearms seized
BSS, Dhaka

Police seized 28 firearms, five other weapons and 71 bullets on the 60th day of their countrywide combing operation, official sources said yesterday.

Polic also arrested 1176 people including 10 listed terrorists from across the country during last 24 hours ending at 6 am.

Of the arrested, 713 were wanted by police and the rest are accused in various cases.

The identified terrorists arrested by the combined force are Mohammad Rezaul Fakir of Khulna city, Mithu Chowdhury of Magura, Bahadur and Mohammad Ali of Satkhira, Mohammad Sarker Hossain of Rajshahi city, Sumon of Tangail, Mohammad Monir of Narayanganj, Mohammad Bulbul of Manikganj, Sirajul Islam of Chittagong and Lutfar Rahman of Comilla.

8 get life term for murder

A court here on Wednesday sentenced eight people to life term imprisonment in a murder case.

The convicts are Abdul Manan, Arshad, Mintu and Ali Hosain of village Bhaturia and Abdul Aziz, his two brothers Faruque and Eshak, and Amin of village Berojbari in Sadar upazila.

The court also fined them Tk 2,000 each, in default, to suffer six months' rigorous imprisonment more.

According to the prosecution, the convicts murdered Altaf Hosain Morai of Bhaturia village on April 4, 1993.

After examining records and witnesses, the Additional District and Sessions Judge Belayet Hosain found them guilty and pronounced the judgement.

BNP demands white paper on corruption during AL rule

BSS, Dhaka

BNP yesterday demanded immediate publication of a white paper on all corrupt practices during the Awami League's five-year rule after a proper investigation.

Describing the past Awami League government as the most corrupt regime in the world, Reazuddin Ahmed, press advisor to the BNP Chairperson, at a briefing said ministers, MPs and their sons and kith and kin were submerged into massive corruption.

Giving a partial picture of the alleged corruption during the Awami League government, Reaz said the country had incurred a loss of about Tk 12 thousand crore in the first six months of 2000 due to corruption.

He also cited some reported allegations of corruption during AL rule including misappropriation of Tk 750 crore in the purchase of seven Mig-29s, irregularities in raising Tk 1100 crore from Tk 300 crore as the prices of equipment in the projects of digital telephone exchange in 58 district headquarters, and handing over of 450 bighas of land for Tk 105 crore to a Singapore-based company near Zia International Airport.

Reaz also referred to the unprecedented share scam, temporary siege of Pride Textile and Monno Ceramics factories, allotment of 301 plots to Awami League men at Gulshan, Banani and Uttara, allotment of 600 luxury apartments constructed for NAM conference to partymen at throw-away prices, and issuance of licenses for banks and insurance companies through illegal gratification.

He explicitly rejected as false, baseless and ridiculous the Awami League's allegation against Begum Khaleda Zia regarding use of illegally earned money for elections.

He said there was no such precedence of conviction of any BNP leaders for corruption. On the contrary, many Awami League leaders were accused of corruption during 1972-75 period, he added.

Reaz said that if elected, BNP would hold trial of those responsible for corruption. In this regard, he mentioned the BNP's pledge to set up an independent anti-corruption commission to deal with corruption.

Cancel permission for FEMA to monitor polls: AL
