AUB condemns bomb blast at AL rally

Association of Universities Bangladesh (AUB), a forum of Vice Chancellors of all public universities strongly censured the bomb attack on an electoral rally of Awami League candidate Sheikh Helal at Moularat in Bagerhat.

AUB in a press release yesterday observed that a vested corner is trying to vandalise the coming general elections masterminding different types of terrorist activities all over the country.

Expressing deep concern over the situation the AUB press release signed by its president and Vice Chancellor of the Jahangirnagar University demanded punitive actions against the culprits involved in the bomb attack.

Voters' ID online

HomeViewBangladesh.com LLC, a private sector company, on their own initiative, has purchased the voters' list (in CDs) from the Bangladesh Election Commission, converted the data, made search option available and successfully made the complete voters' list available to the public in the Internet at www.hvbangladesh.com, says a press release.

People having access to the Internet can now log on to the

above mentioned website, select their district/area and then search by name to get the details of their voter ID. The user can also get an unofficial printout of his/her voter ID from the website. As most of the keyboards of personal computers are in English, HomeViewBangladesh.com LLC has made it possible to type the name in English to do a name search, even though the database is in Bangla.

Hasina condoles death of Peter Shore

UNB, Dhaka

Awami League president and former prime minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday condoled the death of Peter Shore, a British parliamentarian, former minister and member of the House of Lords.

In a condolence message, Hasina said Bangladesh has lost a trustworthy friend at his death.

Recalling his support and contribution to Bangladesh's liberation war in 1971, she said Lord Peter had played a leading role in mobilising world opinion in favour of Bangladesh.

The Awami League chief said the British parliamentarian denounced the killing of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in 1975 and demanded trial of the killers.

Hasina said Lord Peter had also extended support to the democratic movement in Bangladesh. She prayed for salvation of the departed soul.

Rotary Club of Dhaka Central

The installation ceremony of Rotary Club of Dhaka Central was held, recently, at Hotel Purbani International, says a press release.

Professor Dr. Noor Uddin Ahmed, Vice Chancellor of BUET, Dhaka attended the programme as chief guest, while Rotary District Governor Rtn. Abdul Ahad, PHF, B and Valerie Taylor of CRP, Savar took the chair as special guest and guest of honour respectively.

CU stalemate takes toll on academic activities

The unusual vacations and stalemate in the Chittagong University has contributed to session jam.

The university has lost sixty days of academic activities since the caretaker government took office on July 15. It remained open only ten days out of total 70 days.

The university reopened on August 1 after a month-long vacation for rainy season amid a tense situation as the BCL, the student wing of Awami League, and Jamaat-backed Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) prepared for showdown over establishing supremacy on the dormitories.

But on August 10, the Shibir enforced a strike to press home their ten-point demands. The demands include removal of the Vice-Chancellor (VC) and the proctor, rehabilitation of the genuine resident students and recovery of illegal arms from the dormitories.

On the third day of the strike, the BCL and ICS were locked in a gunfight that left 20 students injured. This prompted the authorities to declare the university closed since die on August 13.

Some 16 thousand students of the university are now facing a uncertain future as session jams ranging from six months to two

years have already gripped different departments.

Meanwhile, the Syndicate in a meeting on September 22 decided to reopen the university on October 8 to end the two-month deadlock.

"It is most unfortunate for our students that they will fall into session jam again which we managed to remove from the university in the last few years," said a teacher of political science department, preferring anonymity.

He blamed the student organizations for this situation. A student of journalism department criticised the CU authorities for the session jam. He asked why the university authorities did not take any action against the student organisations who are polluting the academic atmosphere.

Sudanese envoy calls on CA
