AL blames BNP, anti-liberation forces for bomb attacks on rallies

The Awami League leaders yesterday blamed the BNP and anti-liberation forces for the bomb attacks on its election rallies at Bagerhat and Sunamganj.

Briefing newsmen at the AL election office in the city yesterday, the leaders alleged that the attacks were carried out to intimidate the voters belonging to the minority community.

AL joint secretary Mozaffar Hossain Paltu, who is also the member-secretary of the party's election conducting committee, replied to queries of the newsmen while the party's office secretary Abdul Mannan Khan read out a written statement.

The AL leaders observed that the anti-liberation forces were resorting to attacks on the minority community fearing that the voters belonging to the minority community would reject them in the upcoming polls.

The leaders demanded the authorities drop the name of Rustom Ali from the list of presiding officers as he contested the 1991 elections on Jamaat ticket.

They also alleged that a BNP candidate in Dhaka was using the administration in his favour with the help of one of his relatives, Dr Khalilur Rahman, a private secretary to the Chief Advisor.

Biman's 4 leased planes grounded

UNB, Dhaka

The national airlines on Wednesday grounded four of its leased aircraft as the leasing company concerned held back its decision on standing guarantor as asked by British insurance company Lloyds.

Meanwhile, the Biman authorities also moved to the government asking them to stand guarantor for its airplanes, failing which the national airlines would have to stop its operations from September 28, Biman sources told UNB.

Lloyds has asked for a coverage of 500 million US dollars against 'war risk' to the airlines as the world remained wary after passenger planes were used to launch terrorist attacks on targets in the US.

With the grounding of the four leased aircraft-two DC-10s and two Airbus-two Biman authorities also 'fell into crisis in maintaining its flight schedule on the international routes', sources said.

Meanwhile, Biman had to cancel Wednesday's New York flight following the crisis.

Recently the Lloyd also increased premium by 150 dollars for each passenger. Biman last year carried 1.4 million passengers.

Under the current rate, Biman has been paying an annual premium of 50 million US dollars for risk coverage.

Printed voters' list final : EC

The Election Commission (EC), in an announcement said yesterday the printed voters' list finally published on October 26 last year by the commission is the official voters' list for the upcoming general elections.

The announcement came following confusion created over the official status of the voters' list currently available in printed form on colour paper and in compact disc (CD).

Spl steps taken to enable the disabled to vote

The Election Commission has undertaken a special programme to help the country's 75 lakh disabled voters in exercising their right of franchise, an official handout said yesterday.

Under this programme the blind and those unable to move without help will get an aide as per approval of the concerned presiding officer inside the polling booth to help them cast their votes. The electoral laws approved for the disabled voters to enable them cast their votes are being transmitted among the common people, the handout said.

Election will be free and fair, British envoy hopes

British High Commissioner Dr David Carter met Chief Advisor Justice Latifur Rahman yesterday and discussed with him matters related to elections.

During the meeting at the CA's office, the High Commissioner highly appreciated the measures taken by the caretaker government for holding a free, fair and impartial election, officials said.

The caretaker government has been tackling the election situation with great patience and courage, he observed.

Expressing the hope that the elections would be held in a peaceful situation, Dr Carter noted that the caretaker government has the support of the people.

The High Commissioner handed over a letter from the Australian Prime Minister to the caretaker government regarding the conference of the heads of Commonwealth Governments to be held in Brisbane in the first week of October.

The High Commissioner hoped that the next election in Bangladesh would be free, fair and impartial.

BNP denounces call for strike in CHT

BNP leaders yesterday termed the two-day general strike in Chittagong Hill Tracts during the Monday's general elections called by a rebel tribal group as alarming, frightful and undesirable.

They said the decision of strike is a ploy to boycott the election as well as to foil it.

The leaders of BNP National Election Steering Committee at their regular briefing at its Banani office said 'such audacious, imprudent and unlawful' decision of imposing general strike on September 30 and October 1 by a rebel group in the Hill Tracts is a matter concern of the nation and aimed at resisting the polls.
