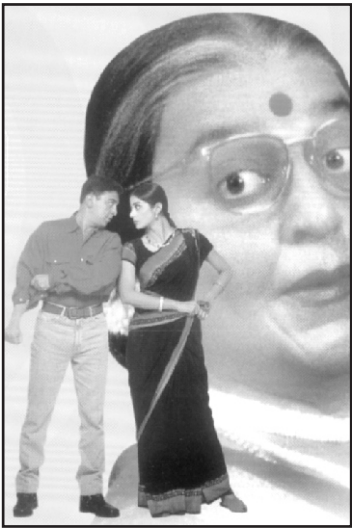
The Movie

Memories, Dreams, Reflections By C.G. Jung, Price: Tk 900 In the spring of 1957, when he was eighty-one years old, C.G. Jung undertook the telling of his life story. At regular intervals he had conversations with his colleague and friend Aniela Jaffe, and collaborated with her in the preparation of the text based on these talks. On occasion, he was moved to write entire chapters of the book in his own hand, and he continued to work on the final stages of the manuscript until shortly before his death on June 6, 1961.



Cooking the World: Ritual & Thoughts in Ancient India By Charles Malamoud, Price: Tk 440 The Vedas give the following definition of man: 'Of all the animals that could possibly be considered sacrificial victims, man is the only one that can perform sacrifices'. The essays in this volume attempt to unravel the doctrine on man that condensed into this sentence. They examine and explore the cultural and forms of thought revealed in Vedic hymns and associated treatises on sacrifices.



From The Diary of A Snail By Gunter Grass, Price: Tk 480 Probably the most autobiographical of his novel, From the Diary of a Snail was first published in 1972. It balances the agonising history of the persecuted Danzig Jews with an account of Grass's political campaigning with Willie Brandt. Underlying all is the snail, the central symbol that is both a model and a parody of social progress and a mysterious metaphor for social reform.
