

Post-polls clashes leave 44 hurt in Pabna, Magura

At least 20 people were injured in post election clashes in different areas of the district.

According to sources, 16 people were injured when supporters of BNP and Awami League clashed at Baragram and Raghunathpur under Sathian thana yesterday morning.

Six critically injured persons - Shajahan, 40, Mahir, 35, Hashem Ali, 40, Kashem Ali, 30, Sabura Khatun, 40, and Mojahar, 25 - were admitted to the Sathia Health Complex.

Another four were injured at Chatmohar in Pabna-3 constituency during the clashes between the supporters of AL and four party alliance.

Some houses belonging to minority community also came un-

der attack, according to sources. UNB adds. Some 21 people were injured in post-election clashes between Awami League and BNP in Sreepur and Mohammadpur upazilas yesterday.

Locals said 14 people were injured and four houses ransacked in a BNP-AL clash at Ramdevpur village in Mohammadpur upazila at about 7 am.

Nine of the injured - Phul Mia, Jamal, Zahur, Aku, Jamal Sikder, Mona Mia, Hira Begum, Panu Mia and Sironnesa - were admitted to local health complex.

Another clash between AL and BNP supporters at village Kochubari in Sreepur Upazila left 10 people injured.

Police later brought the situation under control.

Police were deployed in both upazilas to avert further trouble.

Father, son killed in road accident

One person who just returned from Saudi Arabia and his father died in a road accident yesterday when they were returning home in Comilla from Zia International Airport.

The driver of the microbus in which they were travelling was also killed in the road accident.

Police and witnesses said the three were killed on the spot as a speeding bus rammmed into the microbus, on the Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Chhoygharia area.

Jasim returned from Saudi Arabia yesterday and he was received by his father Salimullah at the airport.

Police said the accident took place at about 5 pm when they were going to their home in Comilla. The driver of the microbus was identified as Jamal.

Two other people were also injured in the accident. They were admitted to Comilla Medical College Hospital "in critical condition".

The bus driver fled the scene soon after the accident. Police seized both the vehicles and registered a case.

Dhaka, Ctg roads wear deserted look

The normally clogged streets of the capital remained deserted for a second consecutive day yesterday as residents preferred to stay indoors in animated discussions of the election results that came streaming in throughout the day.

Even the customary celebrations of the winning party was conspicuously absent as BNP workers and sympathizers abstained from displaying their joy.

At some places, BNP activists did celebrate by playing with colours. But they were few and far between and did little to add to the city's colour.

The city clearly had not shaken off its election hangover even 24 hours later. While a majority of the residents extended their election-holiday by yet another day to savour the break to the full, fear of poll-related violence prompted some to stay indoors.

Though four-wheelers and baby-taxis made a return to the streets yesterday, traffic was thin even at the busiest of intersections. "I wish Dhaka were always like this. It was a pleasure to drive around today with little or no ob-

stacles," said Waliur Rahman, a businessman.

But some did rue the empty streets. Business was dull and traders at shops and roadside kiosks complained of few customers. "It is as good as a day lost. The day resembled a barrel," lamented an idle shopkeeper at the Mouchak crossing.

Still, the capital city breathed easily during the day. With little traffic, vehicular pollution was significantly low and the smog that normally hangs over the city was absent.

Our correspondent from Chittagong adds: An uneasy calmness settled over the port city of Chittagong yesterday after the announcement of election results of the most parliamentary seats.

The city put on a desolate look, as most of the city dwellers stayed home.

Leaders and activists of different political parties were busy discussing the social and administrative changes likely to take place under the next government.

Many considered the victory of the alliance unexpected, while many termed it desired.
