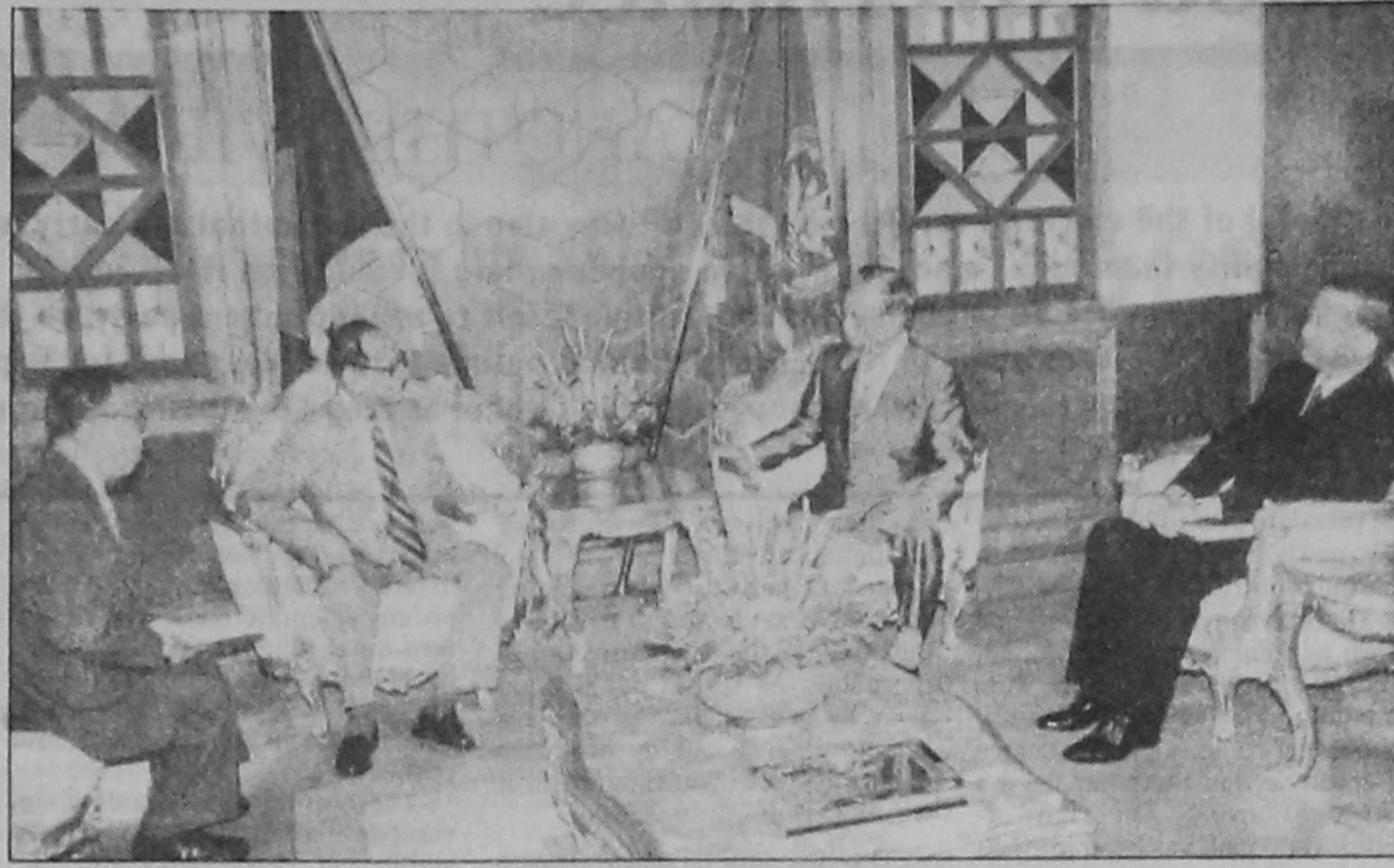
Little change in day temperature is expected over the country during the period, Met Office said.

AL candidate demands repolling in Mymensingh-5

Rashida Mohiuddin, AL candidate in Mymensingh-5 (Mukttagacha) at a press conference at Mymensingh Press Club yesterday evening alleged that BNP nominee AKM Mosarrat Hossain has conducted massive vote rigging, snatching of ballot boxes, and terrorism at seven centres to turn the election result in his favour.

She also alleged that the polling agents of AL were forced out of some centres. She rejected the results of those seven centres and demanded repolling in these centres.

She also told the journalists that despite asking the returning officer, assistant returning officer and presiding officers to control the untoward situation, they didn't take any notice of her complaint. She also criticised the security measures at the polling centres as inadequate.

AL leader Md Abdul Hye termed the situation a 'civil coup'. He also informed that several AL activists were also injured.

AL leaders of Mukttagacha upazila unit were also present at the press conference.

People have rejected AL's misrule thru' polls: Saifur

BNP leader M Saifur Rahman has said that the verdict given by the people in a clear negation to the

misrule and gross irregularities of the previous government that badly 'messed' up the country's economy and administration.

The former Finance Minister Saifur who won a landslide victory in both the constituencies was talking to a group of newsmen at a view exchange meeting held at his residence in Sylhet town yesterday afternoon. Saifur said that the people gave their silent opinion through their ballots, showing a proof of their awareness. The people have really assessed the large scale terrorism, repression on the opposition activists, corruption, assimilation, nepotism and plundering of the national wealth by the Awami League during its regime.

The BNP believes in democracy, so rule of law should be ensured at first along with the freedom of press, Saifur said, adding that enforcement of human rights is another basic thing towards attaining economic emancipation. We will take steps in the education sector especially for the advancement of the women education, he added.

It will be our first task to root out the terrorism from Sylhet as well as from the whole country. Saifur Rahman said at the same time it should remember that, if the next government also fails to curb corruption and in taking other measures on priority basis including the terrorism, the people may again go against them. Large scale plundering of national wealth by the powerful quarters should be stopped at any cost he added. "We have to ensure proper utilisation of our limited resources. Above all, there should be a good and effective governance," Saifur stressed. If we fail to do these things, BNP may also face serious consequences, he opined.

Saifur Rahman said, "with the victory this time, I am now entrusted with more responsibilities. I will have to take some measures immediately for resolving some major problems as a representative of Sylhet. Many places in the suburban areas and other parts of Sylhet had been lacking in gas supply for long due to absence of initiatives." He asserted, that it will be done soon.

We will take measures for development of Sylhet with the help of all, we will ensure participation of all in the process of development," he said.

"Sylhet will be made into a modern city and arrangements will be taken for protection of both banks river Surma, which flows through the divisional town of Sylhet, he added.
