# French show tours Dhaka

Alliance Francaise de Dhaka presents screen print works of Jean-Michel Alberola at its gallery beginning October 7

ASSOCIATION Francaise d'Action Artiste (AFAA) will be holding a touring exhibition of screen print works by Jean-Michel Alberola.

A collection of Alberola's work, on the theme of man's attitudes towards life, will be touring Bangladesh, Indonesia and Japan.

Screen print is usually done on cloth. First, a desired picture is engraved or drawn on a hard surface like zinc, copper or wood. Printing on glass or paper or wood by pouring paint through innumerable holes of the silk or any other cloth as screen or stencil is called Serigraphy. The other mediums of printmaking include Linocut, Lithography and Serigraphy.

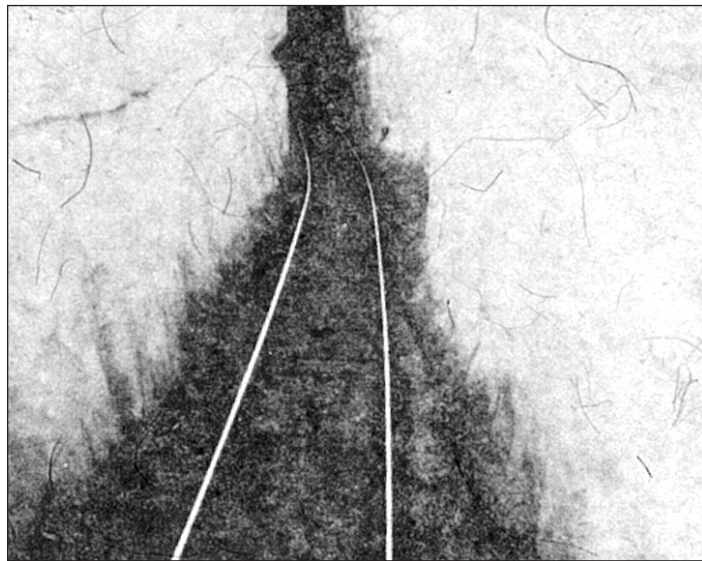
Of Spanish origin, French painter Jean-Michel Alberola was born in Algeria. He has been living in France permanently since 1962. After receiving training in fine art in Marseille, he traveled to Le Havre on the Atlantic and devoted himself to painting.

An ardent believer in Christianity, central issue of Alberola's work is 'Man's atti-

tudes towards life how man takes life or how it should be taken.' The subject matter of his work are greed for forbidden things and its consequence. His work is considered as an outcome of an amalgam of tradition of Western religious art, memory of North Africa, Bullfighting and economy of the contemporary world. Figures and abstract symbols exist side by side in his painting. An heir to Marcel Duchamp and Broodthaers, Alberola has drawn viewers' attention right from his debut show. The work of Alberola are marked with two classical dimensions one deals with Biblical narrative and the other with mythology.

The show is due to be inaugurated in Dhaka by the French Ambassador Monsieur Michel Lummaux. Mahmudul Haque, director of Dhaka Fine Art Institute will be present as chief guest. This show will remain open everyday from 9 a.m. to 12 noon and from 5 to 8 p.m.

This exhibition of Alberola's works will also travel Alliance Francaise de Chittagong between November 1 to 15 from 10 a.m. to 12 noon and from 4 to 8 p.m. everyday.

# Honouring the stalwarts of children literature

Three get M Noorul Quader Juvenile Award 2001

MUSTAFA Hussain, freedom fighter, journalist and writer, has been honoured with the M Noorul Quader Juvenile Literature Award 2001 for his book 'Kishore Jodha Kaishorer Smriti' based on the true stories of the liberation movement of 1971.

The focus of the book is on the encounters of the juvenile freedom fighters with the invaders and children witnessing the blood-laden course of war.

He received the award at a function held at Bangladesh Shisho Academy very recently. Two other authors, Imdadul Haq Milan and Abu Kaiser, were also honoured with the same award.

Rokeya Quader, chairperson of M Noorul Quader Foundation presided over the award presentation ceremony while Dr Rafikul Islam, the DG of Bangla Academy, novelist Selina Hossain and Golam Kibria were honorary guests at the function.

The award has been instituted in the memory of late M Noorul Quader, a valiant freedom fighter and pioneer of garments industry in Bangladesh.

The prize includes 10000 takas and a certificate and crest to Bangladeshi writers for their achievement in literature: fiction non-fiction (the focus is on work concerning the liberation movement of 1971), and poetry.

Mustafa Hussain was born in November 6, 1955 at his maternal uncle's house in village Dhamti, Kumilla. His father is late Kafilluddin Ahmed and his mother is Noorzahan Ahmed.

The independence war of Bangladesh remained always an important aspect of the

writer's experience. This valuable moment of history in fact determined the creative energy of the writer. Like the adolescent freedom fighters of his book, Mustafa resisted the invasion of the Pak armed forces when he was hardly 17 and joined The Bengal Regiment. The eventful aura of the war of independence became an integral part of his vision as a writer and journalist since 1971.

He started his career as a writer in the 70s as a composer of verses. In 80s he emerged as a short story writer in the literary landscape of Bangladesh. His career as a writer of juvenile literature started at the same time. He has already published 9 books. Several of them are children's literature: novels entitled 'Daitya Rajer Judho', 'Judho Sheshar Judho', an anthology of short stories 'Ranga Bhot Ganga Bhoth'.

As a writer journalist Mustafa Hussain traveled across Bangladesh gathering true stories concerning the glorious and pathetic incidents of the wa

of independence interviewed the victims, done documentary works on concentration camps, snapshots of nightmarish incidents and miniatures of war affected lives came into light through different media as a result of his commitment. The book 'Kishore Jodha Kaishorer Smriti' is based on the same subject.

'I believe that the war of independence is deeply etched in our national psyche. I wanted to portray the true picture of the war for our next generation through the book. I have experienced the trauma of Pakistani torture and I want to convey it to our future generation and reveal the fact which has long been kept under curtain.'

In the book there are stories of boys, hardly 6 to 8 witnessing the brutal slaughter of the whole family by the Pakistani forces. Then book on its journey along the haunted terrain of memories tries to get into the psychological experience rather than physical.

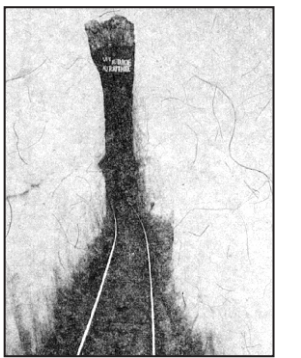

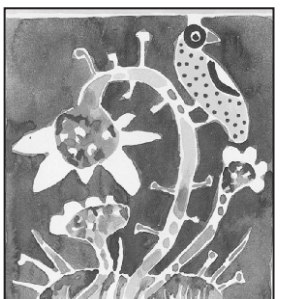


**Debut photo show**
