He alleged that armed terrorists of BNP-Jamaat alliance created an anarchic situation through attacks on AL leaders and workers, common people and minority communities.

In a statement, Zillur said, "The attacks left nine AL leaders and workers dead and over 500 injured in last 24 hours although Begum Zia's pre-election pledge was to make a terrorism-free society.

The Awami League general secretary demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the "identified terrorists."
