Combing operation 813 arrested, 35 firearms seized

Police seized a total of 20 firearms, 15 others types of arms and 24 bullets on the 81st day of the countrywide combing operation, official sources said yesterday.

Of the arrested, 14 persons were caught with arms and police lodged 13 cases under arms act during the time.

Police also arrested 813 persons including one listed terrorists from across the country during the last 24 hours ended at 6 am. Of the arrested, police wanted 370 persons and rest 428 persons are accused in cases under investigation. Police arrested Dablu of Kushtia.

The law enforcing agencies also seized seven explosives across the country of which DMP police recovered 5 abandoned.

AL urged to accept polls results

Peshajibi Samannaya Parishad, a forum of different professional groups, yesterday urged Awami League Chief and former prime minister Sheikh Hasina to accept the people's verdict in the Monday's general election.

Otherwise, they warned, the party would be alienated from the people.

"Several thousand foreign and local polls observers and development partners including the neighbouring India have endorsed the election as free, fair and peaceful... any attempt to ignore the people's verdict will alienate them from the people," convenor of the Parishad Prof Emajuddin Ahmed told a press conference.

SCF demands resignation of JU VC

Addressing the rally in front of the DUCSU building, the SCF leaders also demanded withdrawal of the expulsion order and show-cause notice on activists of Students' Unity for Resistance of Rapists (SURR), who launched a movement against rapists and terrorism on the JU campus.

The SCF leaders asked the JU authorities to cancel the student-ship and certificates of all accused and identified rapists of the JU.

BSU calls for protection of minorities

Bangladesh Students' Union (BSU) yesterday called for steps to protect the minority community across the country from terror attacks.

In a statement, BSU president Hasan Tarik Chowdhury Sohul and general secretary Sharifuzzaman Sharif said repressive acts against the minorities across the country started before the Oct 1 election and marked a rise after the election.

In another statement, they urged the political activists who went on a hall capturing festival after the election, to refrain from this evil practice in the interest of the academic atmosphere in educational institutions.

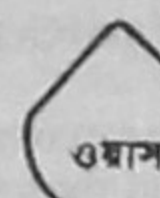
