

## CU reopens October 10 amid tense situation

The Chittagong University (CU) will now reopen on October 10 instead of tomorrow.

The syndicate of the university has decided this in a meeting last night as the campus situation remains tense as before. The three-hour long meeting was held at the VC's office with the CU VC Prof. Fazlee Hossain in the chair.

However, all the dormitories of university will reopen this morning as announced earlier.

The students fear that bloody clashes may take place at any time as the Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) is taking preparations to recapture the dormitories of the university.

The university was closed since die on August 13 after a fierce gunfight between the BCL and ICS, that left 20 students injured.

The ICS, a student organisation of Jamaat-e-Islami, is again trying to take control of all the six dormitories for male students fol-

lowing the landslide victory of the BNP-led four-party alliance while Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), student wing of Awami League (AL), is also determined to keep its hold on to the dormitories.

All the dormitories, six for male students and three for girl students, will reopen this morning and only the genuine students carrying the resident identity cards will be allowed to enter the halls, the university sources said.

The BCL leaders alleged that the Shibir, as part of their action programme to recapture the halls, has gathered its armed cadres from across the country along with sophisticated arms.

They also alleged that the Shibir cadres are threatening the BCL activists but the authority did not take any action against them.

The ICS cadres also beaten up two BCL activists, Saiful and Mamun, both of them are first year students of Chittagong University College, at the university gate no 2

area on Wednesday and warned them not to come here again.

When contacted, ICS president of CU unit Allauddin Shikdar denied the allegations and said, "We want the authorities to rehabilitate our activists in the halls. Our activists will enter the dormitories peacefully and not with arms." He also demanded removal of the partisan people from the administration of the university.

Meanwhile, BCL general secretary Nasir Haider Babul demanded that the authorities ensure security of the students and arrest all Shibir terrorists who are involved in the murders of Bakul, Ayub, Mushfiq and Sanjoy.

## Dy Speaker protests post-election violence

Deputy Speaker and defeated Awami League candidate from Comilla-6, Prof All Ashraf has said rival political activists have unleashed a reign of terror in his constituency since the parliamentary election were held on October-1.

Addressing a press conference at Dollai-Nawabpur Bazar on Friday Prof Ashraf alleged that BNP supporters are launching attacks, issuing threats and looting valuables of AL leaders, workers, and the minority people in rural areas of Chandina upazila.

He alleged that a young woman of Aitchail village was violated and six other Hindu women at Kaduti village were kidnapped by the BNP-backed terrorists during the period.

The Awami League leader said that after the election, BNP terrorists created an anarchic situation in different villages and damaged 50 houses of Hindu families, including the house of the school teacher of Darora village, Kritish Chandra.

He said local businessmen have been refraining from opening their businesses in fear of attacks. They have so far received allegations from Mohichail Bazar, Dollai-Nawabpur Bazar, Kaduti Bazar, Bollahar Bazar, Gôan Bazar area.
