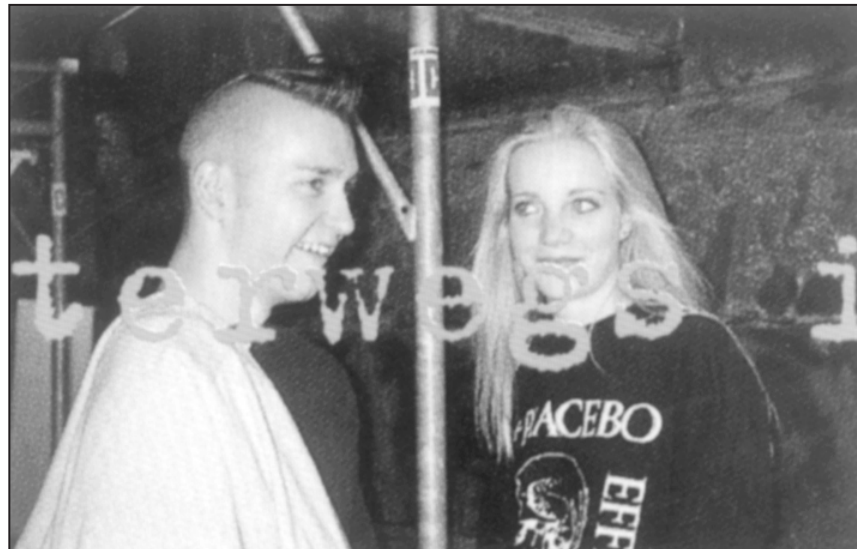

Gothe Institut Dhaka presents snaps from German streets

A show of photographs capturing scenes mainly of Berlin streets is now being held at the Gothe Institut auditorium in Dhanmandi.

Titled Uaterweg in Deutsche land or on the way in Germany, the photography exhibition features some twenty-two snaps portraying a spontaneous and day-to-day life in the

streets of Germany.

All the colour photographs together make up a figurative narrative of fragments of daily activities, glimpse of German way of life, magnificent building and installations, casual gossiping of youths in group on the wayside etc.

One photo on the display capturing a minor German girl showing a boundless wonderment of life evident in her facial

expression.

Magnificence and grandeur vividly expressed in architectural wonders not only captivates the viewers but also remind them of technological excellence and economic might of Germany.

Political activism has been indicated through capturing political slogans inscribed on the wayside walls. This aspect of urban life in Germany corrob-

orates to ours. Busy streets, shoppers at the different shopping malls, daily activities and movements of pedestrians, recreation corner and holiday resort on the sea-beach constitute some other aspects of German's way of life.

The show, which presents a glimpse of Germany, is the work of twelve young photographers.

The collection of photographs is an outcome of how

they look at the strangeness and thinks that appear unintelligible through their lens. It's an expression of how they interpret and present what they encounter with their eyes on the lens.

The team of twelve enthusiast photographers include eleven girls and one boy who won a competition titled 'Think' which the Gothe Institut organized among German language learners in central and Eastern

Europe including the CIS Republic in 1994.

The participating are all between 16 and 21 whose assignment was to find traces of contemporary German history and describe its different aspects.

To serve this end the participants required to have a sound knowledge of Germany, have to visit museums, archives and libraries, and above all to have a

high degree of reflection.

Some work display artistic value, bear mark of talents and a distinct way of looking at things by this band of budding photographers.

The exhibition, which opened on October 7, is open everyday except Fridays and Saturdays, from 2 to 8 pm till October 21.

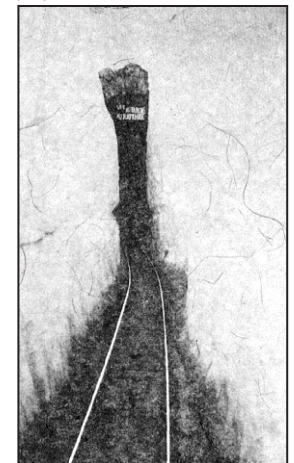
