

S Arabia urged to recruit manpower from Bangladesh

Khaleda calls on Saudi Crown Prince

BSS, Dhaka
Prime Minister Khaleda Zia on Sunday called on Saudi Crown Prince Abdullah Bin Abdul Aziz, who in a rare gesture personally escorted her to his office in Riyadh for official talks.

During the talks, the two leaders recalled their previous meeting at the OIC summit in Rabat at a time when the Muslim Ummah was facing serious crisis, according to a message received in the city.

The crown prince expressed the conviction that the inherent strength of Islam would help it prevail against all adversities. In this connection, he felt that the contribution of Bangladesh helped the Muslim Ummah to solidify its strength.

The prime minister thanked the crown prince for the massive expansion, development and beautification of the two holy mosques. She also thanked him for Saudi Arabia's leadership in consolidating the unity and solidarity of the Islamic Ummah.

Khaleda referred to the initiative she had raised with the Saudi

King Fahd Bin Abdul Aziz regarding building of mosques modelled on Saudi ones in each district of Bangladesh.

The crown prince welcomed this proposal and asked for specific details of the project profile which Saudi authorities could study for possible assistance.

Prime Minister Khaleda Zia also requested the crown prince to recruit unskilled and semi-skilled manpower from Bangladesh. In reply, the crown prince stated that the matter would receive their utmost consideration.

The prime minister raised the issue of closer economic collaboration between the two friendly countries. Crown Prince Abdullah stated that such cooperation was concentrated in the private sector and that necessary follow-up with regard to joint-ventures and other forms of cooperation could be explored through exchange of delegations.

Prime Minister Khaleda Zia invited the crown prince to visit Bangladesh at a mutually convenient time.

During the talks the prime

minister was accompanied by Riaz Rahman, State Minister for Foreign Affairs, Mir Mohammad Nasir Uddin, State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism, Mohsin Ali Khan, Foreign Secretary, Arafat Rahman and Mosaddek Ali.

Japanese PM greets Khaleda

Japanese Prime Minister Junichiro Koizumi and Cambodian Prime Minister Samdech Hun Sen congratulated Khaleda Zia on her assumption of the office as Prime Minister.

The Japanese and Cambodian Prime Ministers in separate messages hoped that Bangladesh's friendly relations with Japan and Cambodia would be further strengthened during her tenure.

Expressing their deep respect to Khaleda on her success in the October 1 election, the two leaders wished good health and success of the new Prime Minister, said a Foreign Ministry press release.
