Call to implement rights of all children

The Child Congress 2001 was observed amid huge enthusiasm at the Bangladesh Shishu Academy premises yesterday with a view to implement child rights and create awareness to discourage child labour.

About 600 children and adolescents from 20 non government organisations (NGO) took part the day-long occasion with a renewed pledge to implement and ensure child rights in the country for the betterment of children's future.

The congress was organised by the Underprivileged Children's Education Programme (UCEP) in collaboration with different NGOs.

Speakers at the programme called on people from all quarters to learn to love children and be more affectionate towards them.

They also stressed on implementation of child rights in the country, especially to facilitate the children a chance to live and grow up in a proper manner as any child deserves. Addressing the

business session of the programme, UNICEF official Ian Peter Cleiburg stressed the need for child education as well as stoppage of child labour altogether.

Director of Shishu Academy Golam Kibria underscored the need to have a fixed definition of a child's age in the country. He added that, "the controversy regarding this must be brought to an end as many children in our country are exploited in different ways due to this confusion regarding their age." He also stressed on the need for birth certificates for every child.

Chair of the session Fatema Akhter, working child, shared her experiences from her own and urged the civil society to help others in her plight. She said, "Please remember, we are also like your own children, we do not seek mercy but your compassion."

The participating children took part in a group discussion on some issues and expressed their views. Editor of The Daily Star

Mahfuz Anam moderated the session as the chief guest.

Ambassador of the Royal Norwegian Embassy Gerd Wahlstrom was present at the programme as the chief guest while senior education advisor, DFID-B, Dr. Terri Kelly and vice president of UCEP Board of Governors Zeba Rasheed Chowdhury were present as the special guests in the inaugural session. Executive director of UCEP MB Zaman chaired the inaugural session.

UCEP student Shumi Akhter presented the keynote paper on "We and Child Rights" while Sakina Akhter delivered the welcome address.

The programme was followed a cultural show performed by the participants of UCEP and other NGOs.

An exhibition on various handicrafts and paintings and drawings prepared by working children was also held at the academy premises.

In a joint statement, Prof RIM Aminur Rashid and Prof Iftekhar Uddin Ahmed president and secretary general respectively of the association yesterday said that after the general elections obstructions have been made against the administrative activities in the universities which is contradictory to the University Act of 1973.

Expressing deep concern over the prevailing post-election situation in the educational institutions across the country, they demanded of the government to take immediate steps to ensure a violence free campus.

Attacks on minority BMSP forms teams to investigate

An emergency meeting of BMSP on Thursday night decided to send the six teams to six divisions of the country, said a press release. The meeting also urged the members of the parliament to stay at their own constituencies and take effective steps to solve the crisis.

BMSP will form a human chain in front of the National Press Club from 11 am to 12 pm tomorrow in protest of such incidents. The meeting also condemned the US attack on Afghanistan.
