Only 8 pc govt officers are women: Study

Some 80 per cent jobs under the women's quota were filled up properly, but only 8 per cent government officers are women, a recent study revealed.

Ministry of Women and Children Affairs conducted the study under a "Policy Leadership and Advocacy for Gender Equality (PLAGE)" programme.

The study noted that women's job quota in the technical cadre is yet to be filled up. On the other hand, the drop-out rate of females at the preliminary and secondary stages of recruitment was higher than that of the males.

The said women's quota utilisations in non-cadre services was 96 per cent. Among the professional cadres, women's quota utilisations in the education sector was satisfactory, but there was less utilisation of female quota in the subjects of Islamic History, Philosophy, Botany and Zoology, the study said.

According to the study, transfer-related problems, lack of childcare facilities, more involvement in household activities, unfavourable working environment as well as lack of security and low literacy rate are the major barriers for women's entrance into the government service.

The government introduced job quota in the public sector way back in 1972. According to this quota, 10 per cent of the vacant posts were earmarked for the women who took part in the War of Liberation in 1971, without disturbing the district quota.

In 1985, the government promulgated another circular reserving 10 and 15 per cent of all

gazetted and non-gazetted vacant posts for the female candidates respectively. This system was introduced for bringing women into the main stream of development.

The study said since only 8 per cent of the civil officers are women, they find it difficult to work effectively in an environment dominated by men. The study recommends the qualifying marks for passing BCS examination for women may be relaxed, if required.

The study recommended that women quota should continue until the equalisation of higher education rate for both male and female with due emphasis on ensuring quality of education.
