Dutch Film Week for the cine-buffs

Zahir Raihan Film Society screens eleven Dutch films at the Goethe-Institut

Zahir Raihan Film Society, country's leading film club that relentlessly trying to present the cine-literate population of the country with new cinematic experiences, is holding Dutch Film Week from November 3 to 8 at Goethe-Institut, German Cultural Centre at Dhanmondi.

Open to all, the film week is featuring three documentary films and eight feature films by Dutch master filmmakers such as Bert Haanstra, Fons Rademakers, Marleen Gorris, Mike Van diem, among others.

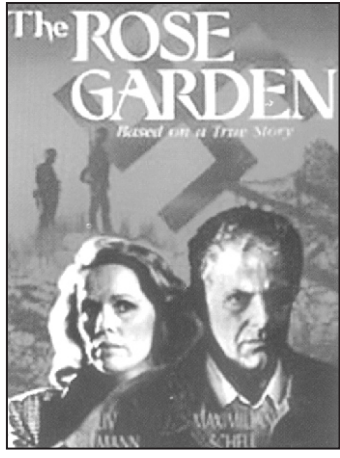
This film week focuses on the contemporary film scenario in the Netherlands. Surprisingly enough, the Dutch film industry, producing around twenty films each year, has won prestigious awards at different film festivals around the globe.

In the last fifteen years alone, the Dutch filmmakers bagged three Best Foreign Language Film Oscars, an enviable feat indeed. Thus Dutch films rank third in position, along with Japan and Sweden, in the Foreign Language Oscar-winning list.

The Dutch cinema, for a long time, was known all over the world through two documentary filmmakers Joris Ivens and Bert Haanstra. They have already secured their positions as two of the all-time best documentary filmmakers in the history of the cinema. The festival features three documentaries by Bert Haanstra: *Rembrandt, Painter of Man* (1956), *Glass* (1958) and *Zoo* (1962). These documentaries were screened on 3rd November at 5:30 p.m. and will again be shown on 7th November at 6:30 p.m.

The short documentary *Glass* alone bagged twenty different international prizes. Two Oscar-winning films, *Antonia's Line* by Marleen Gorris and *Character* by Mike van Diem, will also be shown in the film week.

The first film won the Foreign Language Oscar in 1996 and the latter in 1998. Fons Rademakers' film *The Assault* won the same prize in 1986. His film *The Rose Garden* will be shown. Marleen Gorris's beautiful adaptation of the English novelist Virginia Woolf's novel *Mrs Dalloway* will also be screened as part of the Dutch festival. *The Polish Bride* is a multiple award-winning first feature

film by Karim Traidia which deals with the problems of the immigrants in the Netherlands. Karim Traidia is an Algerian-born filmmaker. The two versions of the film *The Vanishing* by Gorge Sluizer are both suspense films made in the Hitchcockian style.

The film week was inaugurated by Sjeff IJzermans, Ambassador of the Royal Netherlands in Dhaka, on Saturday last.

Directed by Marleen Gorris, film *Antonia's Line* is a vibrant saga combining feminist rigour with an involving dynastic narrative. At 85, Antonia has reached her last day on earth, a moment to reflect on the last five decades since returning to her native village in Holland after WWII years which have seen her raise daughter Danielle, make a life on the farm for herself and a small community of society's flotsam and jetsam, and part from the world a richly experienced grandmother.

Based on Virginia Woolf's *Mrs Dalloway*, director Marleen Gorris portrays Clarissa Dalloway (Redgrave), the beautiful wife of an eminent MP, loves to give parties, sensitively. A day in her life, however, is a serious affair, interwoven with the experiences of a WWI veteran, Septimus (Graves), and a

The Rose Garden, directed by Fons Rademakers, is set in modern Germany where a Holocaust survivor is tried for assault after attacking an elderly businessman on the street. During the trial, the background of the "victim" is revealed he was an SS commandant who presided over the execution of the assailant's sister. The film is based on actual events. Aaron Reichenbacher, a victim of the Holocaust, returns to Germany many years after the war's end to search for his sister. At the airport in Frankfurt, Aaron suddenly sees and attacks an elderly ex-SS officer whom he recognises as the person responsible for the execution of 20 children used as guinea pigs in a series of medical experiments. Aaron himself was one of those children and the only one to escape death. The officer had managed to avoid punishment due to a series of legal loopholes. This gripping drama, which exposes the latent anti-Semitism in modern-day Germany, stars Ullmann as a tenacious lawyer who is hired to defend a man (Schell) accused of committing a seemingly unprovoked attack on an elderly businessman. As the drama unfolds, Ullmann uncovers the fact that the old man was a commandant of a Nazi concentration camp and presided over the death of many Jews and children. A serious, compassionate psychological drama that features fine performances by both Ullmann and Schell as well as an oddly cast but effective Peter Fonda.

Directed by Karim Traidia, *The Polish Bride* tells the story of a girl who has been lured from her native Poland to Holland under false pretences by two men who want her to work in a brothel. She manages to escape and is found beaten and bleeding by Henk, a taciturn farmer, who cares for the weak and terrified woman and offers her shelter until she recovers. Gradually a closeness develops between them as Anna begins to put order into Henk's solitary life and he tries to instill in Anna his love for the countryside. The blossoming relationship is threatened, however, when Anna's 'employers' come looking for her.

An unforgettably chilling psychodrama, *The Vanishing* directed by Gorge Sluizer, twists the slenderest of plots into a hellish exploration of human potential. On a driving holiday in France, a young Dutch couple, Saskia and Rex (Ter Steege and Bervoets), stop at a service station to refuel; as Rex waits, Saskia walks to a nearby toilet and vanishes without trace. Three years later, an embittered Rex finds himself drawn into a nightmarish relationship with Saskia's awesomely mundane abductor, Raymond Lemorne (Donnadieu), who via taunting postcards promises to reveal the fate of his lost love. Consumed by his desire for knowledge, Rex resolves to confront his nemesis and end the Nietzschean conflict of will in which he is embroiled... Adapted from Tim Krabbe's novel *The Golden Egg*, this is a beautifully understated study of obsession that investigates the edges of rationality and the destructive capacity of idealistic devotion. At the heart of its icy spell is Donnadieu's utterly plausible evocation of everyday, madness, a resolutely banal picture of evil. Sluizer's direction is seamless throughout, effortlessly juggling domesticity and damnation as it ploughs inexorably towards an appalling denouement.

Amsterdam is directed by Dick Maas. Having unleashed a killer elevator on us in *The Lift*, Dick Maas here comes up with the authentically crazy notion of a psycho-diver. By prowling (padding) the hundreds of canals which traverse Amsterdam, our wetsuit wacko easily escapes detection, and can engage concurrently in his two favourite sports: diving and murder. Much of the pleasure derives from the outrageous set pieces the film wrings from a familiar formula. Aside from the eccentric psychopath, we have the divorced cop and his obnoxious kid, the bungling sidekick, the blatantly obvious suspect, and the woman relegated to an 'ooh, aargh' role. Yet Maas has talent to burn: snappy dialogue (he wrote the screenplay); brooding *Jauss*-type atmospherics (and music); and stylish execution(s). Like Dario Argento's early slasher thrillers, as a murder mystery it is frankly naff (there is at least one red herring too many); but as a spectacle it is fascinatingly gruesome. Maas murder may not be to everyone's taste, but those who take to tomato ketchup with relish this one is for you.

Kudos for Zahir Raihan for the determination and devotion in inculcating appreciation of good films in the country.

Korea week

Blending tradition with modernity

As a part of the ongoing Korea Week, an exhibition of the paintings of Lee Doo-shik is now being held at the Shilpkala Academy

DOO-shik says about his work, "Here the colours are traditional ones although the presentation is nouveau. What is remarkable is the subtle action of colours and lines in my paintings."

In *Male and Female*, acrylic, one sees an abstract with an impression of a figure of a man, done in

blue thick paint, with protruding legs in black, along with a splash of red, denoting the woman, by his side. The red has flecks of green and the image is outlined with emerald and jet black. Tiny flowers at the side heighten the charm of the female image. At the back are patterns of gray and brown rectangles with gold splashes touched with white and gray. Additions of more gray, gold and white offset the work. Part of the canvas in front is left untouched.

In *Yellow Flower in the Scene*, acrylic on canvas, we see muted images of blossoms done in gold, orange and red, combined with white and brown in the shapes of triangles, rectangles and circles. The forms are heaped against another on a backdrop of shades of muted gray, with motifs coming from the left to the right. Lines of delicate white intersperse the work, while blue motifs are continued in front in blue, purple, jade and ruby red. The flower is highlighted by dots and triangles of bright hues. Sweeps of gray intermingle with white at the back to

offset the subject.

Pond, acrylic on canvas, brings in flowers and living forms with large, fleshy petals outlined with pristine white. The living beings in the pond are seen as simplified geometrical shapes in reds and greens set in murky gray and white. More tiny shapes in gray, black and vermilion are included in the back. Splashes lead out from the back in more vibrant, warm colours. Gold is deftly combined with brown to lend interest to the composition. Despite the abstraction one could easily envisage the magic of the water with its creatures in it as well as the falling blossoms on the pond.

Road to the River, acrylic on canvas, presents the river in lines of gentle blue, scintillating green and dreamy purple. The composition includes two glistening masses of cobalt blue, which includes crosses of white and dots of blood red. A gray, gold and orange path at the side, outlined with dramatic black and swirls of gray and brown with minute flecks of vermilion leads up to the flowing river.

Hostages, acrylic on canvas, introduces us to black dot like images, all in a line, placed in a background of pulsating burnt sienna, blue and red. Triangles of orange, red and black along with masses of silver and white are included on a muted gray and brown backdrop. Bright lines and splashes have been introduced in front to add interest.

Doo-shik has had over 14 solo exhibitions at New York, USA and Korea and over 30 group exhibitions in Europe, USA, the Middle East, Japan and Korea. He has five awards to his credit.

Young-jo Jung, the Korean Ambassador said at the opening of the exhibition that this was the first time that a one-man exhibition of a Korean artist was being held in Bangladesh, and that he was confident Lee Doo-shik's passions and aspirations, which are reflected in his works, will strike a resonant chord with the Bangladeshi people, thus validating the universality of his artistic themes.
