# A treat for gourmets

Curtain falls on Korea Week with an exotic Korean Food Festival, held on November 9 in the city, revealing the soothing aroma and taste of the peninsula

THE approaching winter was in the air, the tinkle of the fork and spoon and the buzz from the tables laid out on the lush green lawn of the Korean ambassador's residence in city provided a great setting for the Korean food festival and a nice orchestration to the grand finale of the Korea Week.

The samulnori or the traditional Korean singing and dancing performed on the occasion garnished the Korean Food Festival to perfection.

Over the past one-week Dhaka had experienced the cultural riches of Korea beginning from November 4 and climaxing with the traditional culinary delights on November 9.

Organised by the Korean Embassy and co-sponsored by the Ministries of Information, Cultural Affairs and The Daily Star, the Korea Week was first of its kind in the cultural scene

of Bangladesh providing a unique opportunity for all to discover the nuances and riches of Korean culture.

The week began with an art exhibition of leading Korean painter Professor Lee Doo-shik at Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy gallery on November 4 followed by a three-day Korean Film Festival at Mohakhali BRAC Center, and a Korean speech contest and Samulnori / Taekwondo show at the Osmani Memorial Hall, a Korean merchandise exhibition at Sonargaon Hotel, November 5-8, gave the variety and diversity of the Korea Week.

Madame Jung, wife of the Ambassador of Korea, presented a song on the concluding evening of the week before a select guests. The vocal performance was a surprising gift for the guests who enjoyed the entire evening in superb moods of joviality and pleasure. There were also some fine presentation of traditional Korean dance and music punctuated in between dinner.

A wide variety of Korean dishes including fish, vegetable, and chicken broadened the choice of the guests.

Kimchi, one of the most favourite items among the Koreans, found a foremost place at the food festival. Bae choo (cabbage), Moo (radish) and O-Pee (cucumber) were included in the menu of Kimchi with the mentioned vegetable being submerged in gravy and syrup of various spicy ingredients! The well-decorated item of Kimchi pulled the guests with its attractive red gravy alongside with green and olive preparations of the cucumber and cabbage. A large carp-shaped fish was lying upon one of the front-line tables with an inscription of Domihoe / Chungpo nuk. Japchae / Goonmandu, NAMUL / O-Yee / Suk-jo were some other varieties of dish. Special dishes like Hoosig / Chapssal twigi / chapssal Choen byung also featured while Bugogi, a combined preparation of chicken

and pork took the attention of the majority of food connoisseurs present near the tables.

Bibimbap and Gimhap, two of the more common specialties of Korea, got their respective shares among the plates of the guests as the former one turned out to be 'meal in a bowl'. Bibimbap featured an artful layered arrangement of vegetable, eggs and meat with sauce over rice. Since ages, it had been a representative dish of southwestern Jeolla-do Provinces, famed for their intricate art, culture and exotic cuisine. Gimhap, on the other hand, seemed more to be a snack rather than an item of the main course. It was, too, a mixture like its cousin Bibimbap, but also a square bamboo rolling mat with 8 to 10 sheets of sea-weed!

The taste of the food and an encounter of the rich cultural heritage of Korea will no doubt remain fresh in our collective memory for a long time to come.

# Oriental arts of Taekwondo and Samulnori enthrall Bangladeshi audience

An important ingredient of the just-held Korea Week, speech contest of Korean language and shows of Taekwondo and Samulnori held at the Osmani Memorial Hall amid enthusiasm

WE live in an age with remarkable inflow of cultural elements from one land to the other. Culture of the modern day world enjoys an unrestricted access beyond the border.

"Cultural interaction and exchange is a very conducive way to enhance mutual understanding and strengthen bilateral ties between two nations," Korean Ambassador to Bangladesh Young-Jo Jung made the remark while talking to The Daily Star on the occasion of Korean speech contest and musical and martial art shows on Nov. 8.

Full to the brim, the audience's enthusiasm for Korean traditional art and culture went unbound virtually acclaiming Korean art exponents and organisers alike. The occasion opened with the passage of some congratulatory remarks and points made by distinguished guests and dignitaries.

Organised by Embassy of the Republic of Korea and Co-sponsored by the Bangladesh Ministry of Information, Korean Community and The Daily Star, this episode of the week presented a synthesis of cross-cultural events including Korean folk music, traditional martial art, Korean speech contest and Manjuri dance of Bangladesh. The organisers meant such cultural co-performance to manifest amity and friendly bondages between the two nations.

Information Minister Dr Abdul Moyeen Khan made an impressive note glorifying Bangladesh's ties with the Korea since the former's emergence as a sovereign nation. "Korea Festival will significantly enhance the ties between the two countries. The kind of message the Festival is conveying will help broaden mutual co-operation at various spheres. Despite having political unrest, Korea has made tremendous economic progress. We can draw and apply instances of socio-economic development from Korea success," Dr Moyeen remarked. He underscored the necessity and justification of cultural progression alongside that of economy, saying, "though economic development is essential to move forward, a country without

cherishing its tradition, heritage and richness of culture can not qualify in the ultimate test of civilisation." He appreciated different aspects of Korean martial art known as Taekwondo.

Korea is proud of her age-old own cultural heritage and distinguished cultural potential. The significance of the event of Korea Week is that such comprehensive extravaganza of Korean culture is first ever in Bangladesh since the establishment of diplomatic ties between these two countries in 1973.

In his introductory remark

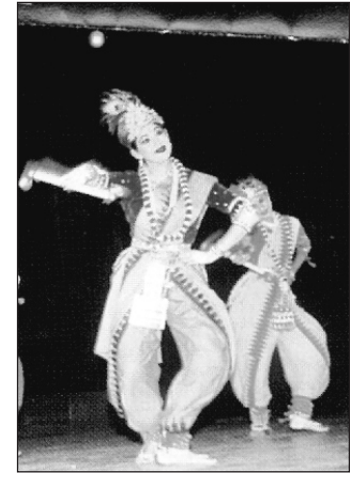
uniqueness of rhythm tempo and technique of this musical show moved all irrespective of their cultural affinity. Samulnori is musical composition made up of instrumental tunes and beatings at a varied notations produced along with dance. It is played at the new year's greeting, at the wedding ceremony, during harvest festival. Throughout the ages, instruments like 'Kkwaeng-gare' and 'pungmul' had been indispensable part of Koreans lives even in battles or funerals. Traditional and folk ceremonies feature Samulnori as an essential part.

Fourteen contestants took part in the Korean speech contest first ever competition of its kind in Bangladesh. A panel of three Korean language experts were present to judge the contestants language competence. Out of fourteen participants one came out as the best speaker while six others received consolation prize.

Taekwondo show enthralled the audience most, producing excitement and wonderment. Two thousand years old Korean martial art, Taekwondo is an art of self-defence. Though similar to other martial arts in some aspects, Taekwondo emphasises on the use of legs and feet through powerful kicks. Experts of this art have manifested their acrobatic skills breaking boards ten feet above the ground or hitting multiple targets in mid-air. A Korean national sport, Taekwondo has rapidly spread over many foreign countries because of its focus on the development and discipline of both the body and the mind. Adopted as a regular event in the tenth Asian Games, some thirty million people practise this sport in more than one hundred and forty countries.

Two folk dance sequences showed glimpses of Korea's cultural tradition and heritage.

Manjuri dance, one of the Bangladeshi classical dance forms, was staged by Tamanna Rahman along with her troupe. Titled "Goshthe Leela" the day's sequence portrayed an episode of young Krishna. The demon Bakasur attacks Krishna while playing with his friends in the field. Good wins over evil when Krishna along with his friends fights back the demon.
