'Ruling party should ensure presence of opposition in JS'

The ruling party in the present legislature with a two-thirds majority has special responsibility to ensure the presence of the major opposition by giving them enough opportunities for discussion of macro- and micro-issues, speakers at a seminar yesterday said.

the Opposition in Bangladesh" held at the GIRDAP auditorium was organised by the Governance Coalition.

Dr Al Masud Hasnuzzaman, professor of the Department of Government and Politics, Jahangirnagar University, presented the keynote paper at the seminar with Feroz M Hasan of FEMA as moderator.

The speakers suggested that both the ruling party and the opposition have accountability both inside and outside the parliament. The media can also play a significant role in highlighting the obligations and responsibilities of the legislators.

Dr Hasnuzzaman in his paper said the building of democracy depends largely on the establishment of a political tradition of consensus among the competing political parties on the winning party's right to form the government and on the opposition's to criticise the party in power.

In a democratic process, one great contribution of the opposition is its role as an important mechanism of imparting political education to the masses and of involving them in the country's politics, he continued.

"But the past experience depicted that both the party in power and the opposition were found inefficient in performing their designated role in parliament."

Professor Muzaffar Ahmed of the Dhaka University (DU) said that if the opposition legislators did not think of themselves as people's representatives, the parliament would never be effective.

Govt urged to place bill on reserved seats for women in JS

Different women's organisations yesterday strongly criticised the new government for its delay in tabling the bill seeking an increase in the number of parliamentary seats for women and direct elections to them.

Leaders of the organisations expressed concern over indifference of the government to female representation in the Jatiya Sangsad (JS) before adjournment of the first session of the eighth parliament.

Leading women's and human rights organisations and NGOs organised a mass rally in the city yesterday to press home their longstanding demand.

The leaders of the organisations demanded passage of the bill in the first session of the eighth parliament by making the 14th amendment to the constitution.

They held both the Awami League and BNP responsible for abolition of women's reserved seats in the parliament.

There is no reason why the BNP government dillydallies in passing the bill, as it has a two-thirds majority required for any amendment, they said.

They put forward some proposals including increase of women's seats to 100 as adopted in the Beijing Women's Conference-1992, direct elections to those seats and legal steps by the Election Commission regarding this.

A tough movement will be launched across the country, if the government fails to pass the bill in the current or next parliamentary session, the leaders warned.

Fouzia Khondkar Sumi of Pro-sika, Rokeya Kabir of Bangladesh Nari Pragati Sangha, Ayesha Khanam, Dr Maleka Banu and Bela Nabi of Bangladesh Mahila Parishad, Kazi Nasreen Siddique of Usha, Khalilur Rahman of Jatiya Andha Kalyan Sangstha, Ayesha Islam of Bangladesh Trade Union Centre and Shireen Banu Mitel of Prip Trust, among others, addressed the rally held at the Central Shahed Minar.

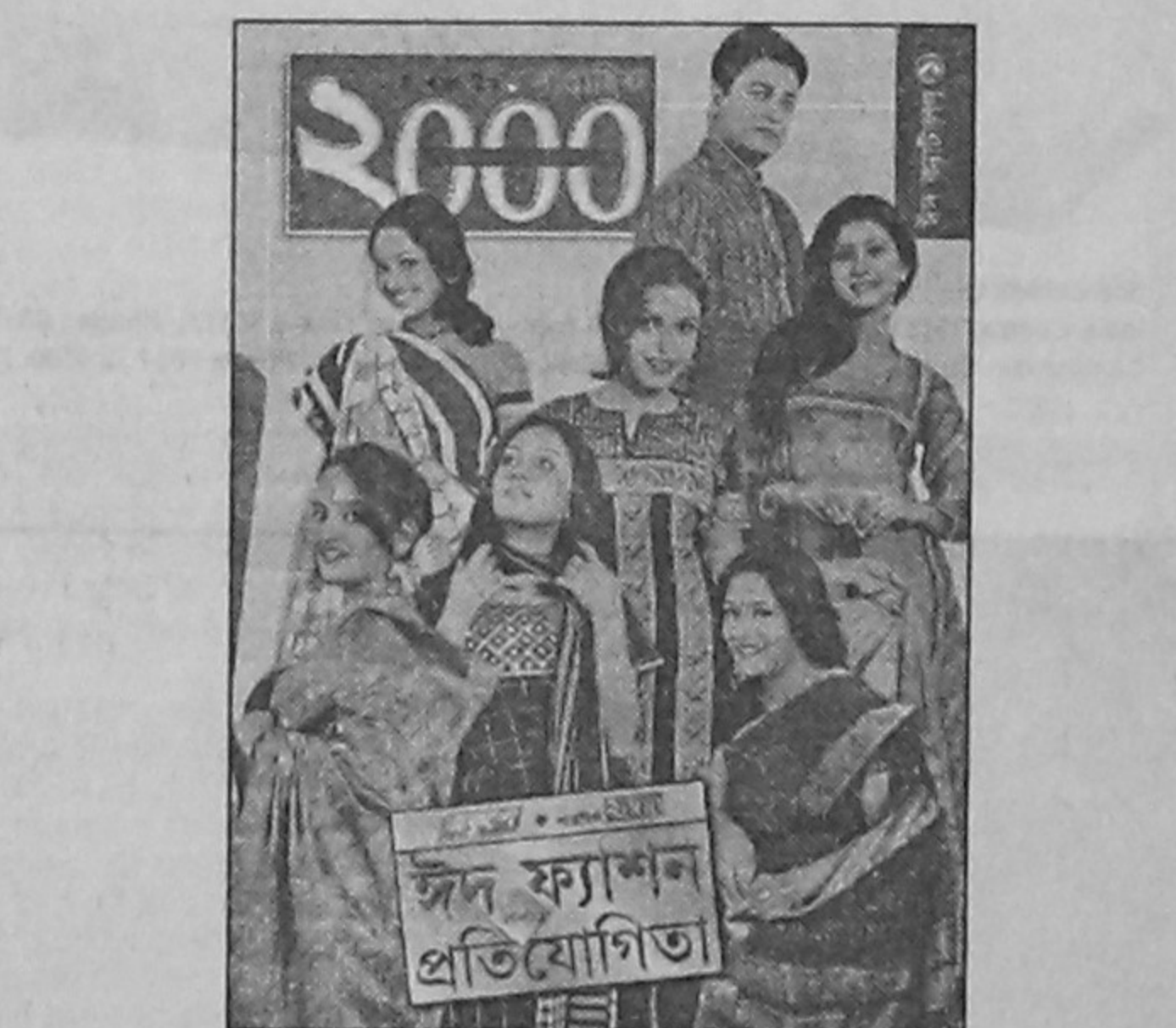
