

## PM hosts iftar party for orphans, ulema

## BSTI drive to check sale of adulterated food items

Bangladesh Standards and Testing Institution (BSTI) has began a special drive in and outside the capital to prevent sale of adulterated food and beverage and sub-standard items in the holy month of Ramadan.

Six vigilance teams in Dhaka and two in each division are taking part in the drive in addition to the regular mobile courts so that dishonest traders could not cheat the consumers, said a press release.

In Ramadan, the BSTI will take stern action particularly against the marketing of adulterated food and beverage, edible oil, confectionery items, and low quality cosmetics, garments and gold ornaments.
