

DCC urged to repair damaged roads

The Old Dhaka People's Welfare Association yesterday at a meeting called for expansion of the roads in the city's Joy Kali Mandir area to facilitate vehicular movement, says a press release.

by Convenor of the association Mahub Uddin Chowdhury, speakers urged the Dhaka City Corporation to repair the damaged roads in different parts of the city. They also urged the police to strictly implement the ban on

movement of trucks on the Loharpul-Postogola Road in daytime.

The Dhaka WASA has also been requested to reconstruct the run-down sewerage system in Faridabad, Gandaria, Sutrapur, Narinda, Wari, Laxmibazar, Bangshal and Nawabpur areas.

MP hostel rooms yet to be allotted to AL lawmakers

Opposition Chief Whip complains

Despite submission of a list to the Parliament Secretariat, Awami League lawmakers were not yet allotted any room in the MP hostels, opposition chief whip Vice Principal Abdus Shahid complained yesterday.

Talking to reporters at his parliament office, he said the ruling party MPs have already occupied all the rooms of the hostels while the Awami League MPs who have no houses in Dhaka were staying in different city hotels.

Abdus Shahid, who is also a member of the House Committee that deals with the matter, has not received any notice of the meeting of the Committee. According to a Parliament Secretariat notice, some 46 suites and rooms have been earmarked for Awami League.

But those suites or rooms have not been allotted despite submission of the list of Awami League members, he told reporters. Although the ruling party is prom-

ising to extend cooperation to the opposition, it is not seen in practice, he said.

In reply to a question, the opposition chief whip said an abnormal situation marked by terrorism, killing, rape, loot and extortion prevented Awami League MPs from coming to parliament. Thousands of Awami League leaders and workers, he said, are displaced today in the wake of terrorism, torture and harassment by "BNP-Jamaat terrorists and administration."

A complete anarchic situation prevails across the country, he alleged, saying that some 266 people were killed and 213 women raped in last 25 days since October 1 according to official count. But the government fails to bring the situation under control, he added.

"If the situation takes such alarming turn in first 30 days of the government, one can very well guess what lies ahead in the next 70 days," the opposition chief whip said.




