**Moyeen Khan says Govt to ensure free flow of information in BTV, Betar**

Information Minister Dr Abdul Moyeen Khan yesterday said the government is determined to ensure free flow of information in Bangladesh Betar and Television along with other electronic media to promote fundamental spirit of liberal democratic system of governance.

Dr Moyeen said it is a matter of great satisfaction that the news of Bangladesh Television is getting back its lost credibility and many business establishments are approaching towards BTV authorities for getting slots for broadcasting their commercial advertisements.  
He said in the last couple of weeks BTV has failed to accommodate many broadcast (commercial advertisement) requests due to time constraints.

He said the government would actively promote objectivity and neutrality while disseminating information in the electronic media.
