Shaheed Sirajuddin's anniversary of death today

The 30th death anniversary of Shaheed Sirajuddin Hossain, a noted journalist and former executive editor and news editor of The Daily Ittefaq, will be observed today.

Collaborators of the Pakistani occupation army killed Sirajuddin on the night of December 10 during the War of Independence in

Sirajuddin's political commentaries on the turbulent days of 1971, published in The Daily Ittefaq, a Bangla daily, are considered the historic documents of the War of Independence.

Sirajuddin maintained a close contact with freedom fighters. He intercepted a secret document of Archer Blad, the then consulgeneral of US Embassy in Dhaka, and sent it to the office of the Mujibnagar government, through which the world came to know about the mass killing in Bangla-

Pioneer of the investigative reporting in Bangladesh, Sirajuddin received the Magasasy Award for his report, which saved 64 children from being trafficked. He also received the Ekushey Award and PIB Award for his extraordinary contribution to journalism.

He wrote many books including "Look into the Mirror" and "Itihas Katha Kao", and played a pivotal role in the Language Movement through his writing.



Order to remove illegal structures from Rly lands

UNB, Dhaka

The government ordered removal of all illegal structures from Bangladesh Railway lands in different parts of the country.

The summons came from a high-profile meeting on recovery of illegally occupied lands of BR and its land management policy at the Communications Ministry with Communications Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda in the

"For the welfare of people as well as of the state, the meeting decided to introduce a timely policy" for management of BR land and start countrywide drives to recover the grabbed lands evicting unauthorised holders. It was informed in the meeting

that some 668 acres of land of BR eastern zone and 1002 acres of western zone were somehow being occupied illegally.

The Railway authorities have been asked to submit a complete report containing unused and illegally occupied lands of Bangladesh Railway to the Communications Ministry.

The five-year SEMP to be ended in 2003, was initiated as a follow up of the landmark National Environmental Management Action Plan (NEMAP) which recommended specific programmes and intervention for the protection and management of environment in all sectors in 1995.


Petrobangla GM Mohiuddin dead


