# 32 murdered in city in AL plans agitation first 12 days of Dec traders, a housewife, an alleged

Thirty-two people were murdered in the city in the first 12 days of the current month, which is more than the figurers in December last year and in December in the previous year.

In December last year, 27 people were murdered in the city and the figure was 23 in December 1999. Police records say 49 people were killed in the city last month and

30 in October. Of the 32 killed in 12 days this

month, 14 died in mob beating. Of those beaten to death, eight were suspected as muggers, two as dacoits and four as extortionists. The rest include a Jubo Dal
