An agreement to provide basic education to the children working in bidi factories was signed in Dhaka recently between International Labour Organisation (ILO) and BRAC, says a press release.  
Shengjie Li, Officer-in-Charge of ILO, and Aminul Alam, Deputy Executive Director of BRAC, signed the agreement.  
According to the agreement, BRAC will set up schools in Haragacha area of Rangpur district to accommodate 2948 children working in the bidi sector to divert them from bidi making which is extremely health hazardous.  
These children will receive 18 months of basic education after which they will be admitted into grade three in government primary schools.  
The children aged between 15 and 17 will also be imparted training for better employment and provided with basic health care including regular health checkup for them and their siblings.  
Their mothers will be absorbed in BRAC's micro-credit programme with a view to providing economic support to their families. The programme also includes awareness building among the community against harmful effects of child labour.
