Environment and Forest Minister Shahjahan Siraj yesterday urged The delegation, led by its the citizens not to use polythene to protect Dhaka from a colossal ecological disaster.

Shahjahan Siraj directed all government, semi-government, autonomous and private offices The minister made the appeal not to use polythene shopping bags. He also asked the concerned entrepreneurs and executives of jute-based industries and paper-Mayor of Dhaka Mohammad bag makers to make their products available in the markets as early as possible.

He assured that alternative employment opportunities would be created for all entrepreneurs and workers who would be af-

fected after imposition of restriction on the use of polythene sop-

The inter-ministerial meeting stressed the need for launching a massive campaign in Betar, Television and national dailies for highlighting the magnitude and significance of the issue.

Meanwhile, the government sought allout cooperation from the print and electronic media in its extensive campaign against the use of polythene shopping bags across the country, particularly in Dhaka City.

"Certainly we will go for the ban on the use of polythene shopping bags in Dhaka City from the first January next. But, prior to that we need an extensive last minute campaign to include people in the move voluntarily," Environment and Forest Secretary Sabihuddin Ahmed told a press conference

Information Secretary Syed Margub Murshed and Chairman of the Forum of Environment Journalists in Bangladesh (FEJB) Quamrul Islam Chowdhury were also present and replied to different questions from journalists in the conference at the Information

The government has plans to impose ban in phases on the uses of thin polythene bags that have already posed serious threat to land fertility, environment, public health and sewerage system of different towns and cities.

Referring to the directives of Prime Minister Khaleda Zia for putting ban on the use of polythene shopping bags across the country by next two months, the environment secretary said prior to the ban, government wanted to allow a 'breathing space' to the users and manufacturers to adapt with the new situation voluntarily.

He also said a week longcampaign would continue till December 31 to motivate people in this regard.

When asked about the immediate alternative to polythene bags, he said government has already asked BGMC and BTMC to innovate environment-friendly shopping bags at cheaper rates. Jute mills in public sector have given the assurance of providing 12 lakh bags within a short time, he said misgo & paleon seli

Margub Murshed said government wants to encourage use of indigenous 'thonga' (packets made of paper sheets) in the country instead of polythene bags. He said if necessary, financial support would be given to the thonga' makers who provide employment to a number of poor.
