**BHRC to observe by-polls in five constituencies**

Bangladesh Human Rights Commission (BHRC) has decided to observe by-elections in five constituencies, scheduled for January 17, says a press release.

The constituencies are Narail-1 and 2, Barguna-3, Munsiganj-1 and Faridpur-4. The commission will station one centre-based observer in each election centre, two mobile units for each constituency and one central mobile team under the leadership of BHRC Secretary General.

**Ex-SPARSO Secy Mir Hossain dead**

Mir Hossain Ahmed Chowdhury, former secretary of the Space Administration and Remote Sensing Organisation (SPARSO), died at a private hospital in the city yesterday at the age of 57, family sources said.

Chowdhury had been suffering from heart ailment for long.

He left behind his wife, two sons, a daughter and host of relatives and admirers to mourn his death.

**'Launch awareness campaign to stop violence against women'**

Identifying dowry as one of the factors leading to violence against women, they said enforcement and reforms of existing laws is a must to stop such practice.

The speakers also urged politicians, community leaders, and family members to put in their best efforts to root out dowry culture from the society.

The dialogue on 'Repression on Women and Dowry' was held at a local restaurant in the morning. Jointly organised by the Prothom Alo, a leading Bangla daily, and the British Council, Dhaka, the session was moderated by resident editor of the daily Abul Momen.

The speakers also called for removing gender discriminations from the family as well as the society.

They regretted that the dowry system is now being considered widely a 'gift'.

"The custom of dowry in the name of gift is not an isolated affair. Dowry culture has been incorporated and absorbed into our culture as an endearing ritual and it's being practised in all forms by well off section as well as low-income groups," they said.

**Qulkhwani**

Qulkhwani of former minister Barrister AR Yusuf will be held tomorrow after Asr prayers at his residence at 181 Gulshan Avenue (North).

All family members, relatives and admirers have been requested to attend the qulkhwani.

Barrister Yusuf died of cancer at Combined Military Hospital here on January 11.

He was minister of Civil Aviation and Tourism, Information, Law and Justice from 1984 to 1985.

He was also the chairman of the board of directors of Biman Bangladesh Airlines in 1986.

S/he must have analytical skills that span areas such as strategic planning, field/action research, and extensive field experience in programme management.

The person should have exceptional facilitation and organisational skills to plan, organise and prioritise work within deadlines and be able to work in a challenging environment. S/He will have proven experience in co-ordinating and managing small projects and programmes. Have strong networking, conflict resolution and negotiation skills with a keen interest in exploratory work. Have the ability and easiness to write reports and proposals with a very good command over Bangla and English. Salary commensurate with experience.

**HEALTH & NUTRITION: Programme Officer** - We are looking for a bright and energetic individual willing to make a commitment to learning about and advocating for children's rights in Bangladesh, especially, in terms of the health and nutrition (H&N) of children.
