30 drug addicts held in Khulna

Police on Sunday arrested 30 young drug addicts from Skid Ghat and Roosevelt Jetty Ghat and recovered 27 home-made hand bombs from their possession.

The arrested are members of a syndicate of drug traffickers, police said.

Police raided Skid Ghat when two rival groups of drug traffickers were locked in clash and traded gunfire. They chased each other exploding bombs during the clash. They clashed over financial matters, police said. Ring leaders of the drug syndicate managed to escape during police operation.

Meanwhile, businessmen of Skid Ghat on Sunday said armed cadres of Ershad Shikder let loose a reign of terror to continue their trade activities.

Pilferage of fuel and food-grains, drug trafficking and river crimes have been rampant at Railway Colony and Junction, Skid Ghat and Roosevelt Jetty Ghat during the last two months, the businessmen said. They pilfered fuel and foodgrains are being sold to blackmarketers and smugglers, the businessmen said.

Drive against old vehicles to be intensified

The government has decided to intensify ongoing special drive against ramshackle transports for removing traffic jam, check air pollution and restore discipline in traffic on city streets.

It was decided at an inter-ministerial meeting at the commerce ministry with Communications Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda in the chair.

The meeting observed that the on-going drive against old transports has strongly been supported by the citizens and substantial progress and positive results were made in checking air pollution, traffic jam and development of environment.

The meeting asked the BRTA authorities and traffic police to make the drive a success by verifying the fitness of three-wheelers from January 31 to February 18 and affix fitness, route permit and taxes paying stickers on the windshield of the vehicles.

The meeting also decided that the transports which would be qualified in the verification would given opportunity to turn it into CNC with the cooperation of donor agencies and private entrepreneurs.

The meeting informed that in view of starting of the special drive substantial number of double-decker buses were introduced on different city streets by BRTC to ease the trouble of citizens in last one and half week.

Apart from this, steps were also taken to encourage private entrepreneurs to introduce new transports, the meeting noted adding if necessary new buses would be imported and private sectors would be encouraged to introduce locally made buses in the city.

The meeting also decided to take legal action against the taxicab which refuses to give service to a customer during his necessity.

State Minister for Home Lutfozzaman Babar, State Minister for Communications Salah Uddin Ahmed, Home Secretary Dr Sadat Husain, Commerce Secretary Syed Rezaul Hayat, DC-traffic of Dhaka Metropolitan Police and heads of the BRTC, DCC, Rajuk, BRTA and DTCB attended the meeting.
