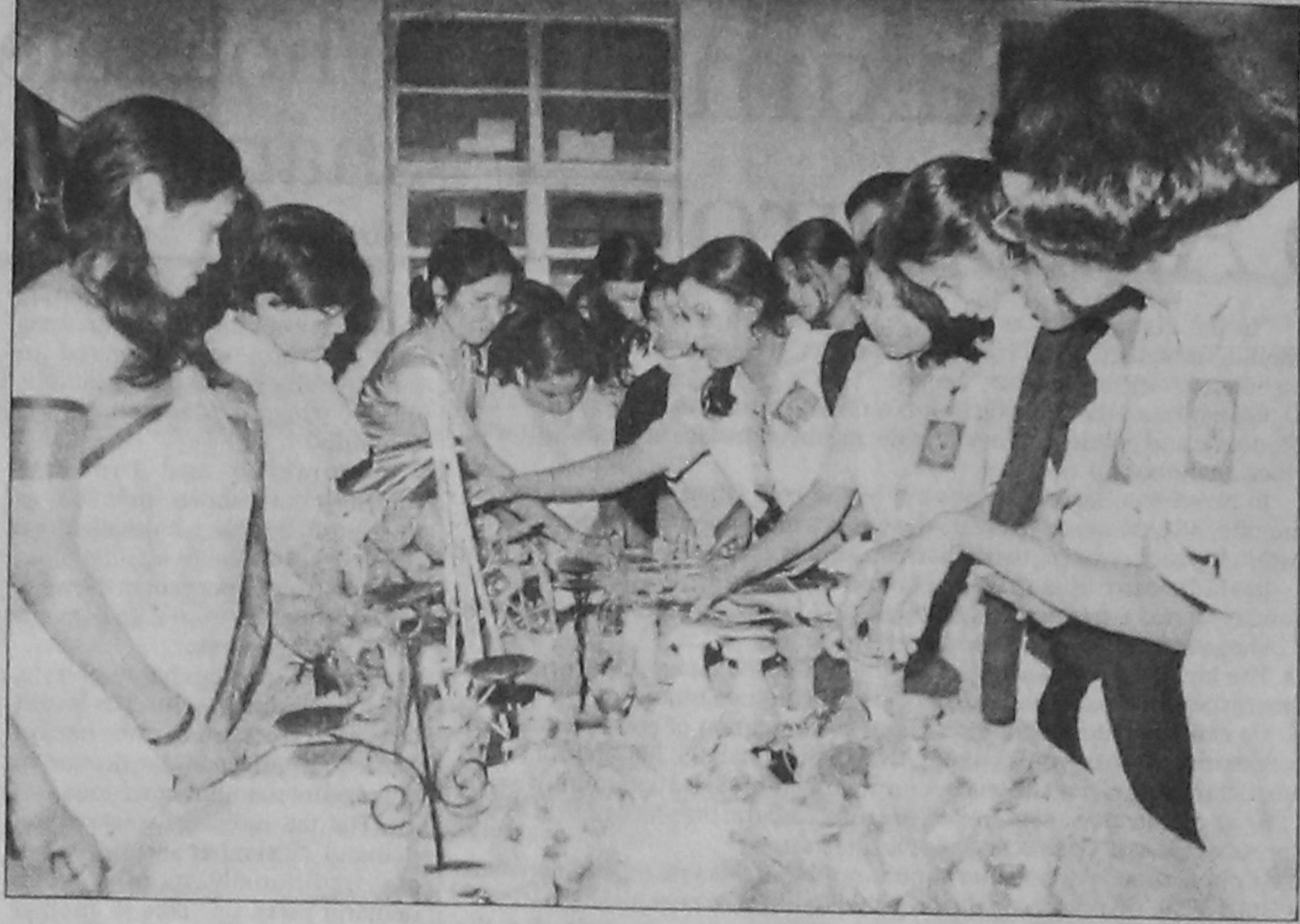
The election to the central committee for 2002 - 2003 was held on Thursday at 41 centres across the country including central office and 5 centres out side the country where 9000 voters cast their votes.

Earlier Engineer Dr. MAK Azad was elected vice president (administration and finance).

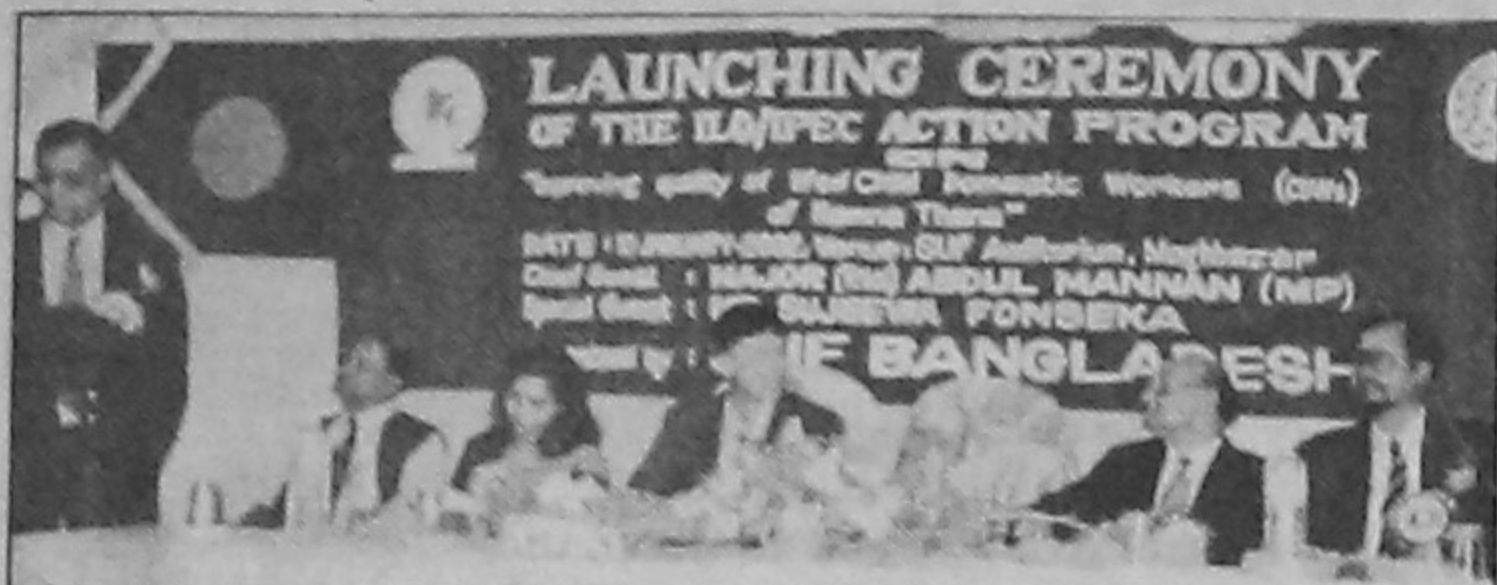
