DESA starts snapping illegal lines

Dhaka Electric Supply Authority (DESA) formally launched its drive to disconnect power distribution lines of illegal users and bill defaulters in the city yesterday.

The drive was launched with snapping off the electricity distribution lines of the Beg Rubber Industries at Teigaon Industrial Area.

State Minister for Power Iqbal Hasan Mahmood and DESA Chairman SM Shamsul Alam witnessed the drive on the spot.

DESA, which is now burdened with an outstanding bills of Tk 2,317 crore at different government and semi-government organisations, private enterprises and individuals, has earlier notified subscribers to pay their arrears by January 10 this year.

The government organisations outstanding dues to DESA is Tk 54 crore, the semi-government and autonomous bodies Tk 825.52 crore and the private organisations and individuals Tk 1,040 crore.

Before starting the line snapping drive, Iqbal Hasan Mahmood told the DESA officials and employees that there was no alternative to cutting the illegal distribution lines to save the whole power sector.

He asked them to hand over the illegal subscribers to the law enforcing agencies. He also called upon people to boycott the illegal power users and bill defaulters socially.

Results of HSC Programme-2001 under BOU announced

Bangladesh Open University yesterday announced the results of its HSC Programme 2001 with the pass percentage of 40.48.

A total of 7,594 students of 1998 batch appeared in the examinations, of them 3,074 students came out successful.

Of the total passed students, 20 secured first division, 1,466 second division and 1,588 third division, says a press release.

1209 more held

BSS, Dhaka

Police seized 14 firearms and 286 bullets during their countrywide drive in the last 24 hours ending at 6 am yesterday, a police headquarters press release said.

They also arrested 1,209 people, including two identified terrorists, during the operation.

Of the arrested, 624 persons are wanted by police and 576 accused of cases under investigation.

Six persons were caught with arms and police lodged six cases under the Arms Act.

The identified terrorists arrested in the drive are Moshir Rahman of Jessore and Marfat of Meherpur, the press release said.
