

## Proshika refutes allegation

Proshika a leading NGO, has protested the reported allegation of its involvement in politics and campaign in favour of Awami League.

According to some newspaper reports, Shafiqul Haq Chowdhury of ASA said in a joint press conference following Thursday's meeting with the Prime Minister that Proshika had campaigned for the Awami League in the last parliamentary elections.

"This is totally untrue and smacks of a conspiracy. Chowdhury's statement is simply intended to damage Proshika's image, to stop the flow of foreign assistance from the donors and to alienate Proshika from the government and different international organisations," said a protest note from Proshika.

As there were reports that Proshika, one of the largest NGOs of the country, did not participate in the meeting with the PM on January 17 in spite of being invited, it clarified that it did not know anything about the meeting until the news broadcast on the television.

"We did not receive any invitation to join the meeting either," the protest note said.

It further said, "Proshika has never been involved in party politics, nor has anything to do with such politics at the moment and will have in the future."

"Proshika has been working for the last 26 years to advance the process of poverty eradication and sustainable development and to promote good governance, democratisation, human rights and women's rights as an integral part of these objectives."
