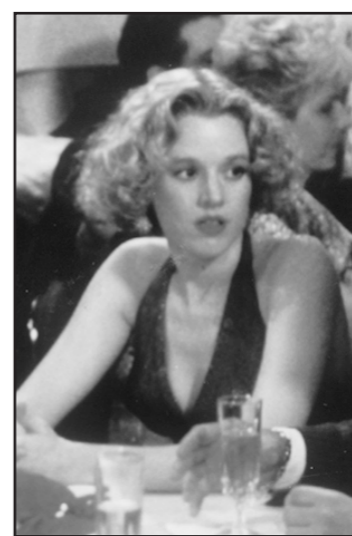
### The Movie

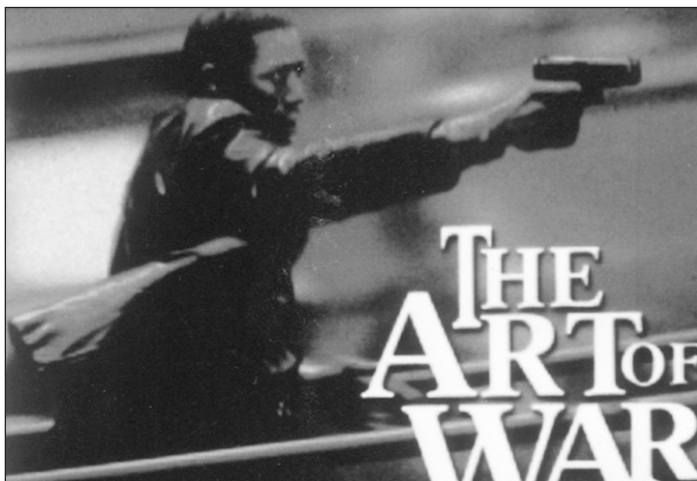

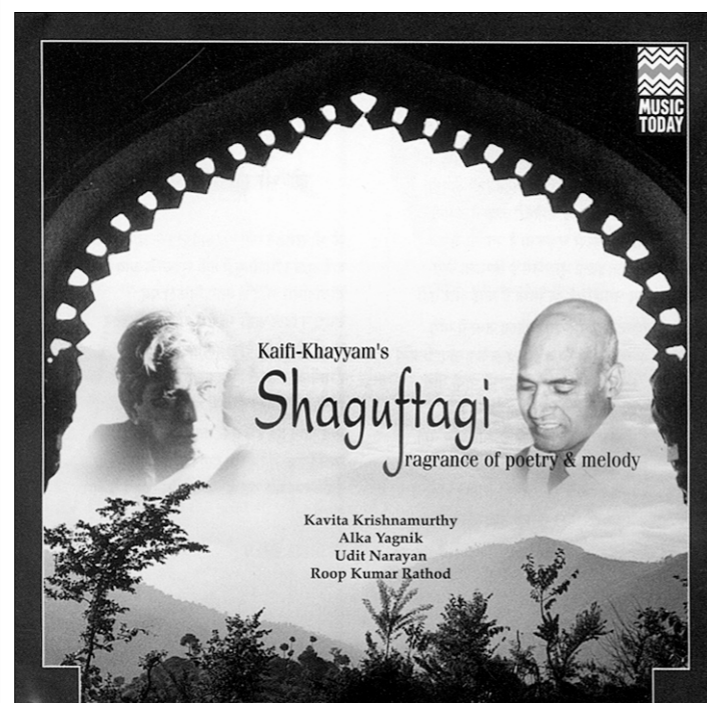


**K-9** on HBO on January 28 at 10:00 PM

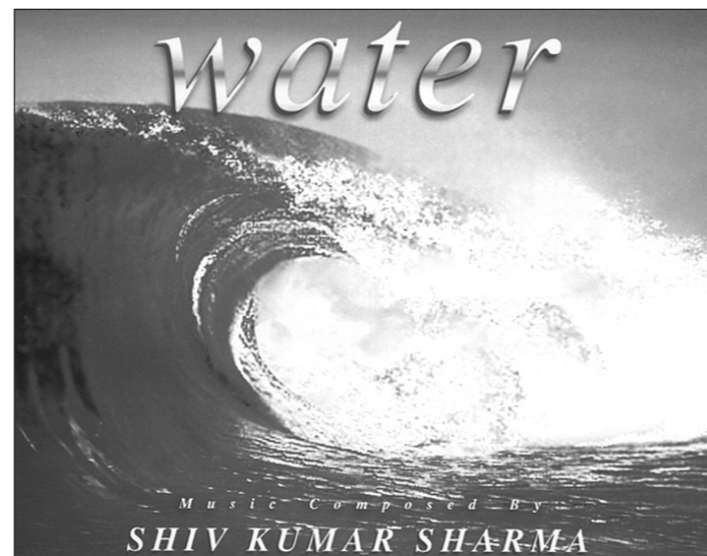

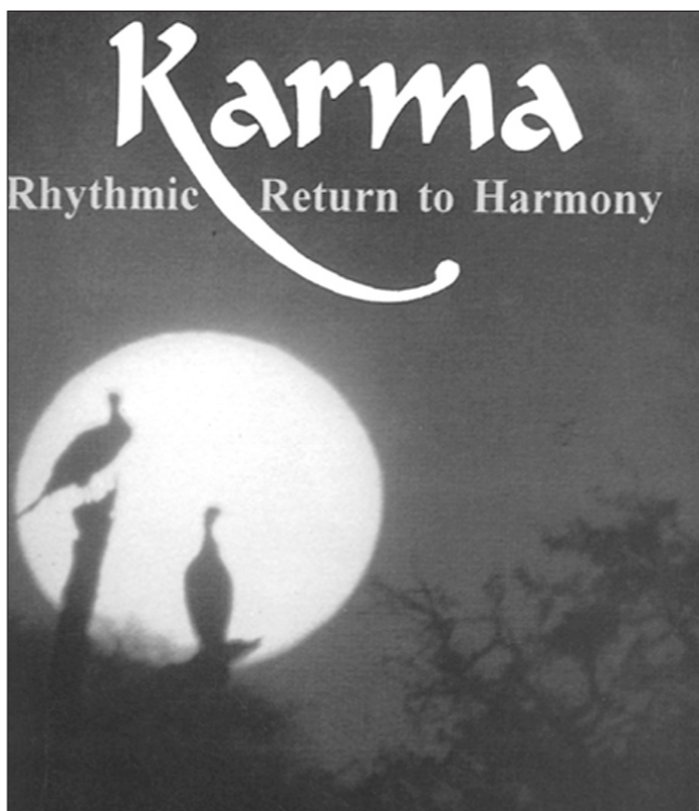

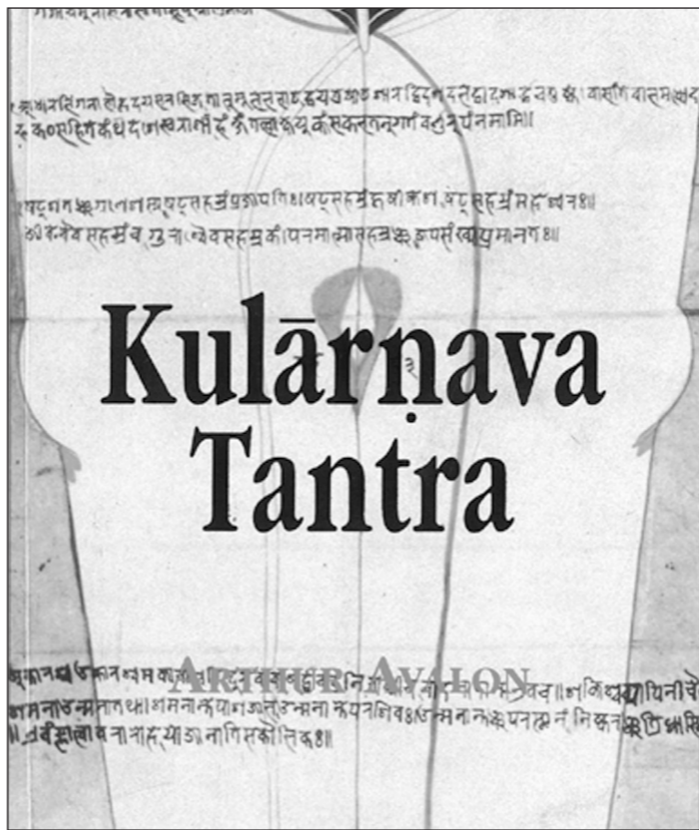


**The Elements of Water**

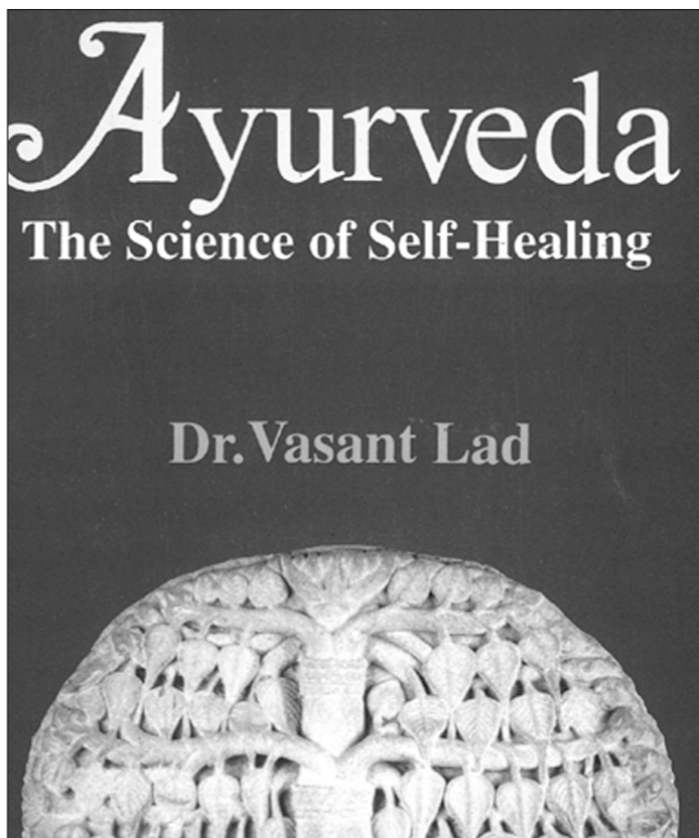

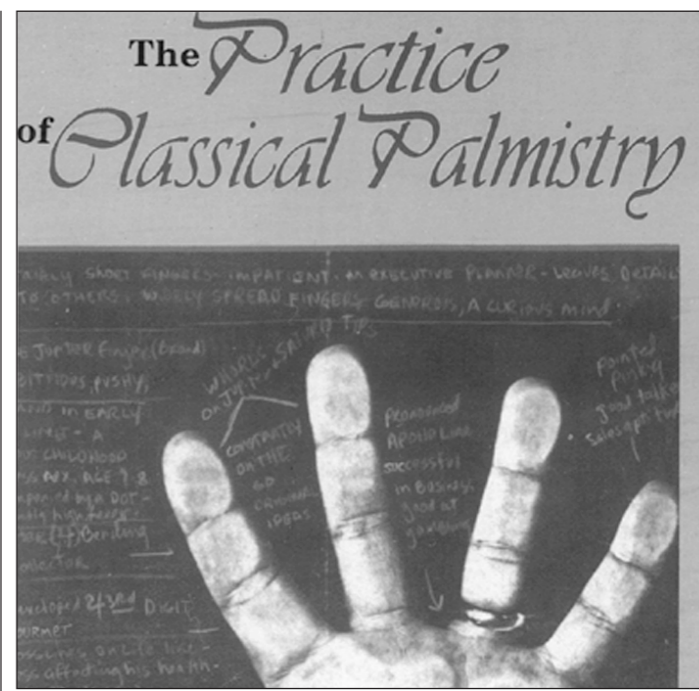
**Karma**

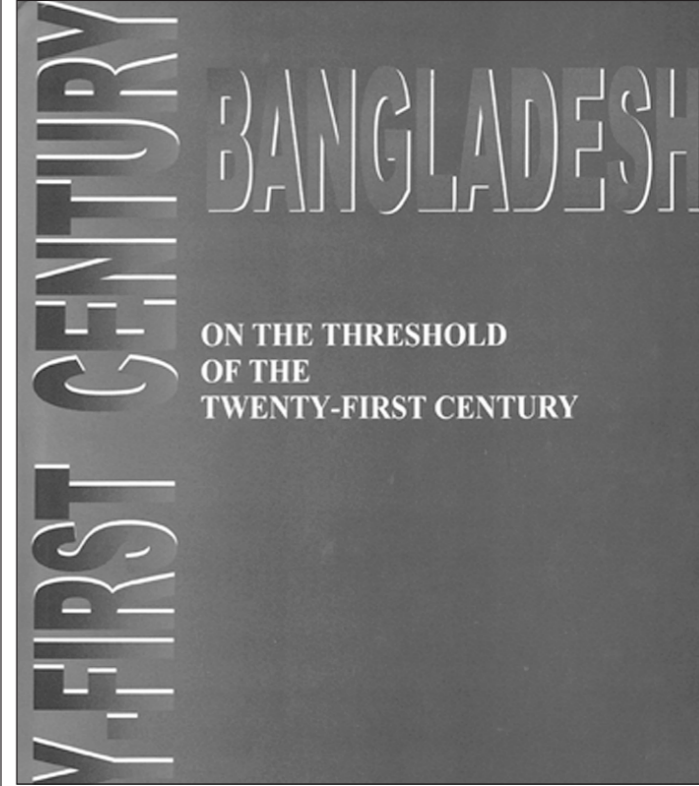
**Kularnava Tantra**

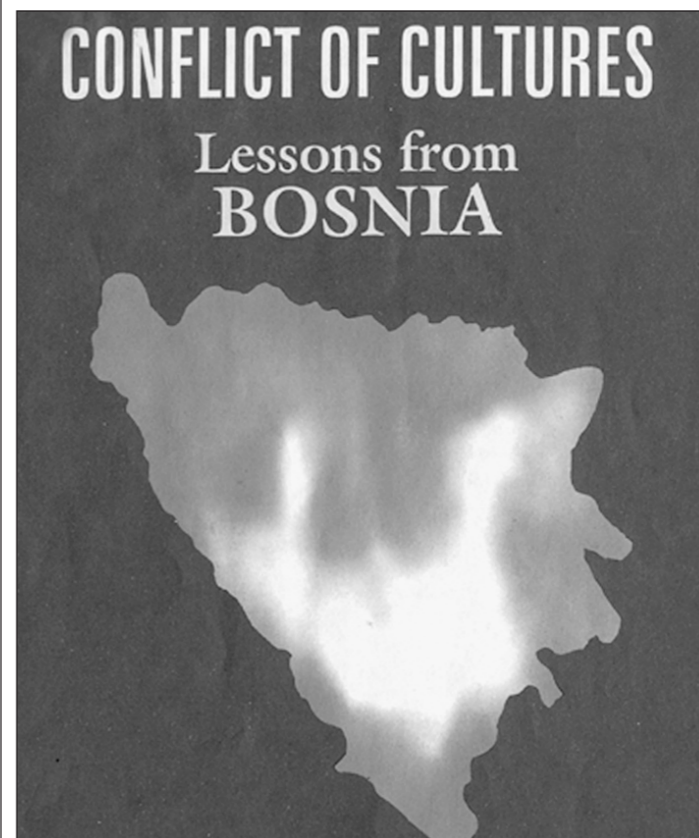
**Ayurveda**
