Moudud urges opposition to join parliament

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Barrister Moudud Ahmed yesterday urged the main opposition Awami League to join the Jatiya Sangsad for ensuring accountability of the government.

Come to parliament and play a serious and constructive role to establish good governance in the country, an official press release issued from his sitting while addressing the seventh biennial general meeting of Bangladesh chapter of the Amnesty International (AI) yesterday.

Ambassador of the Netherlands in Bangladesh Niels Steyn Nink joined the function as special guest.

The minister said it is difficult to implement human rights fully in a country like Bangladesh, as most of the people were unaware of their fundamental rights.

He stressed the need for expansion of education along with development of socio-economic condition of people for protecting human rights.

Barrister Moudud described the free education for women as a major step for protecting their rights and urged the NGOs and the media to work together to make people aware of human rights at village level.

Referring to government initiatives to ensure human rights, the minister said the process for separation of judiciary from the executive, establishment of an independent national commission on human rights and appointment of an ombudsman is almost completed.

Vice chairman of the AI, Nepal, Raju Sarkar and Executive Chief of BRAC Fazle Hasan Abed also spoke on the occasion.
