## Checking up on health records of passengers at ZIA suggested

UNB, Dhaka

Speakers at a discussion yesterday suggested checking up on health records of all passengers at the entry points including airports and border to prevent spread of HIV/AIDS.

They said both incoming and outgoing passengers should be examined during their arrival and departure particularly at Zia International Airport to identify HIV/AIDS carriers.

Bangladesh Manobadhikar Sangbadik Forum (BMSF) organised the programme at a local restaurant where reporters from national dailies took part in discussion on "HIV/AIDS and Media."

BMSF chairman Iny Ilias presided over the meeting while its general secretary Khairuzaman Kamal, former vice-chairman of national STD/AIDS network Habiba Tasneem, media specialist Selim Samad and BMSF consultant Ahmed Ilias spoke on the occasion.

In view of the lack of awareness about HIV/AIDS, the meeting

suggested that media could play a vital role in making the common people aware of the deadly disease.

BMSF will talk with the Ministry of Expatriate Welfare about introducing a system for expatriates to provide information about their health on their arrival and departure.

The meeting emphasised on counseling programme to the outgoing people prior to leave the country so that they don't make any sexual contact without protective measures against AIDS.
