I welcome the 2nd Convocation of American International University-Bangladesh (AIUB).





workstations are actively running on different platforms (Win98/98/NT/2000, Linux, AIX-Unix, OS/400). These are currently six computer laboratories each having thirty to 40 workstations for student uses. All these laboratories run in Windows 98/NT/2000 operating system that can be used for programming in Pascal, C/C++, Java, Oracle, MS SQL, Internet and e-mail, AS/400 access, RDBMS, Visual Basic, and other software in Windows platform. Most of the PC workstations are upgraded on a regular basis to cope up with the cutting-edge technology.

Creativity is highly encouraged among the IT students, which has given birth to a number of software developments for the purpose of automation and computerization of the university. Some of the software developed by the IT department are the in-house Library Database System, Payroll System, Student Registration & Management System, etc. The university recognizes that established foreign software companies are simply looking for countries that offer a stock of trained technical labor for software development.

Records show that AIUB's performance in the ACM-International Collegiate Programming Contest has been a slow and steady way of going to the top. Two teams in 1998 were ranked 7th and 14th out of 47 participating teams. In 1999, two teams secured 7th and 9th positions among 34 teams. In the same year, the winning team participated in the ACM-ICPC site in IIT Kanpur, India securing the 12th position among 54 competing teams. In 2000, AIUB team ranked 7th and 14th in Kanpur, India and Singapore, respectively. The year 2001 saw an enormous success story in the ACM competitions by the AIUB teams. The AIUB team ranked 2nd in BUET and Kanpur, India site respectively to qualify for the World Finals to be held in Honolulu, USA in March of this year.

Apart from the four large campuses with spacious classrooms which enhances student learning to its fullest, AIUB offers some unique facilities that few if any private universities offer, which include a language lab to help students in their English proficiency, a well-equipped gymnasium, an auditorium, and a medical center. In addition, numerous student clubs and organizations give them extra-curricular opportunities that ultimately help them to become tomorrow's leaders.


