Prof Rahman also won 'Course Proposal Competition Award 2001'.

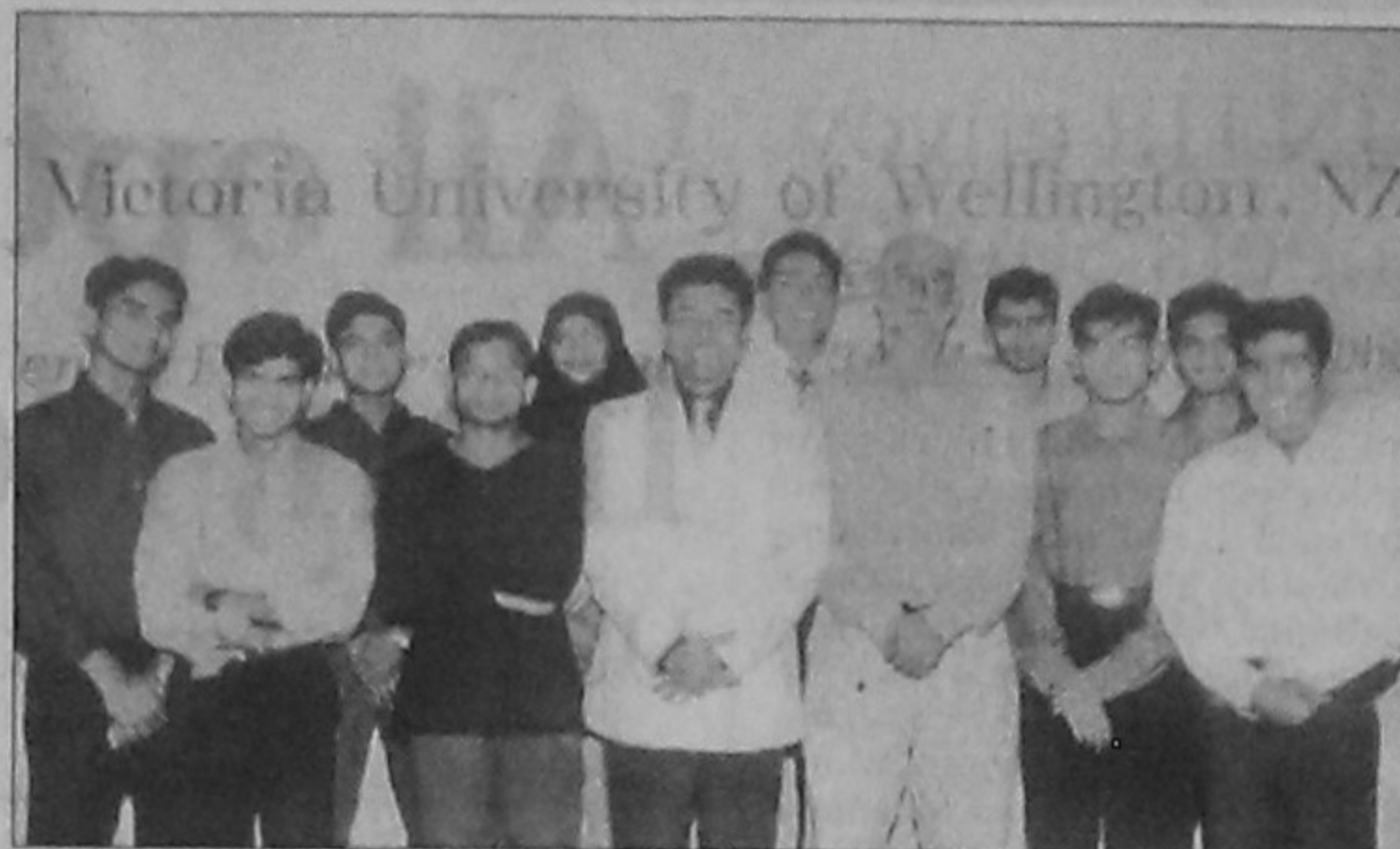

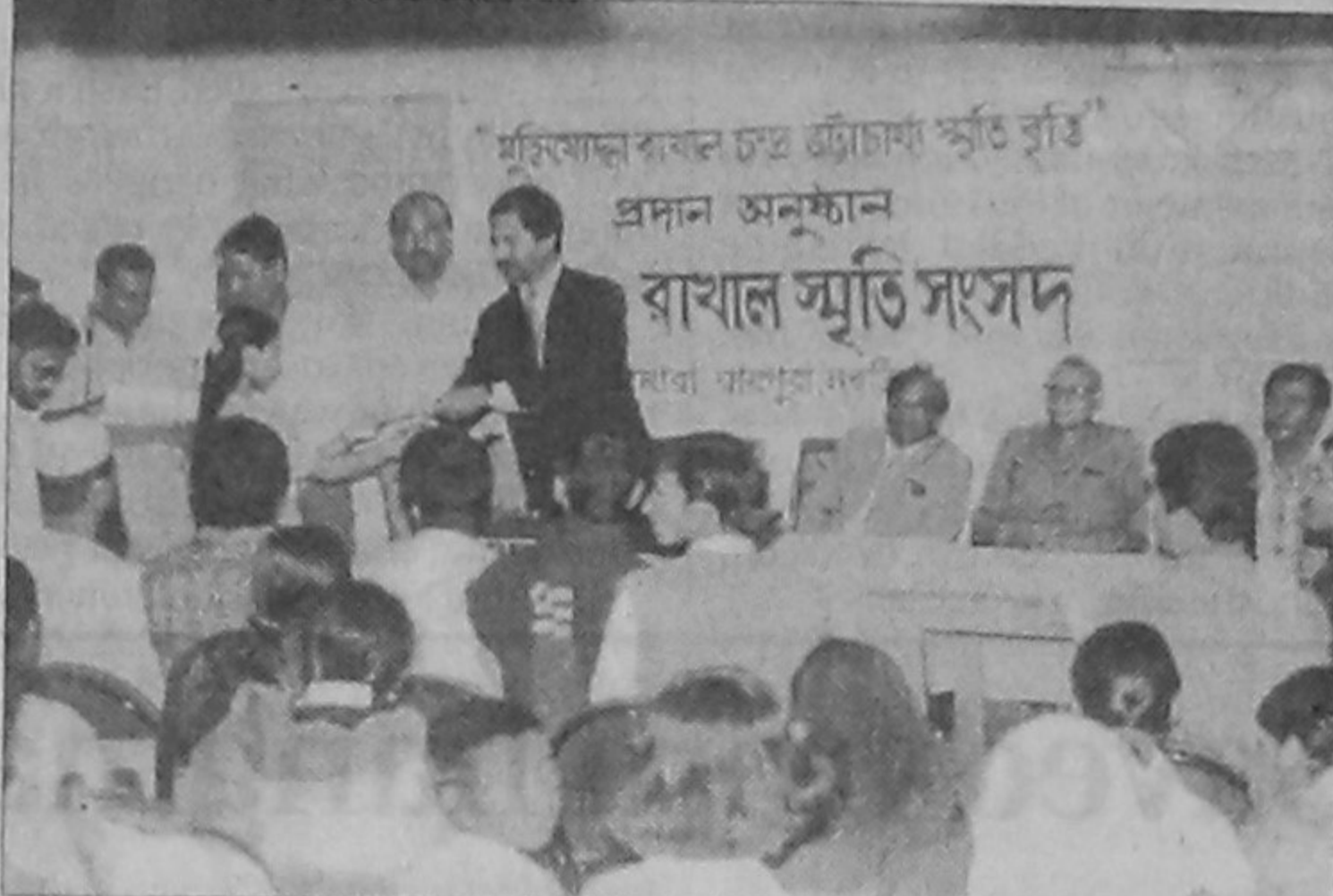
Qulkhwani of Prof. Nurunnahar Begum will be held after Asr prayer tomorrow at her Banani residence, family sources said.
