

#### Ranen Kushari passes away

Ranen Kushari, an eminent radio drama personality, died at BIRDEM Hospital in the city last night after prolonged illness at the age of 81, says a press release.

A producer, director and artiste, Ranen Kushari had been admitted to the hospital on Februarv 22.

He left behind his three sons and a host of relatives and admirers to mourn his death. One of his sons, Samir Kushari, is the chief cameraman of Bangladesh Television.

Born in Bikrampur in 1921, Ranen Kushari was awarded Ekushev Padak in 1980.

Ranen Kushari worked for the Swadhin Bangla Betar Kendra. He of America since its inception.

A former head of the drama Academy, Ranen Kushari received many awards. Tenasinas, Thatre, Bulbul Academy, Hrishij, Udichi and Bangladesh Betar awarded him for his contribution to the cultural arena.




