'Public life in Bhola miserable'

Abdullah Al Islam Jacob, an Awami League candidate of the Oct 1 national election from Bhola-4, yesterday alleged that police in their area hardly register a case without the recommendation of BNP leaders.
"Widespread violence unleashed by BNP goons in entire Bhola has made public life miserable," he told newsmen at a news conference at Dhaka Reporters' Unity.
Jacob said the BNP terrorists had been perpetrating inhuman torture on Awami League leaders and workers in Charfashion-Mompura (Bhola-4) area and collecting tolls since the national election.

Describing a horrifying picture, he said the BNP men killed a small trader, Khudiram, having failed to realise toll from him and killed Priobala after rape. Another girl, Ujala, committed suicide after being raped by the BNP men, he said.
The AL leader said the BNP terrorists attacked his house on Feb 26 and ransacked it in his presence. "Police denied to provide me security following pressure from the BNP men," Jacob said.
"The killers and criminals belonging to BNP are moving in the area along with police," Jacob alleged adding the BNP goons were taking away crops, fishes and cattleheads from the houses of Awami League workers and supporters.

Many long marchers 'don't know about gas'

Navana CNG conversion centre opens in city
UNB, Dhaka

The state minister for energy yesterday scoffed at organisers of the long march toward Bibiana that began Wednesday protesting what they called a move to export gas.
"It's unfortunate that there are many educated people among the long marchers, they don't know about gas, they don't want to understand economy," AKM Mosharraf-Hossain said at the launching of Navana CNG conversion centre in the city's Tejjgaon area.
"There are many proposals for alternative uses of gas. We are waiting for reports of two expert committees to take a decision. But they began a long march, I don't understand why," he said.
Italian Ambassador Mario Filippo Pivi and Navana Chairman Shafiqul Islam Kamal also spoke at the launching ceremony.
Navana, a pioneer in country's automobile sector, launched the conversion center, second in pri-

Canada to help improve environment

UNB, Dhaka
Canada has assured of its continued financial and technical support to Bangladesh for improving its environmental condition.
Canadian High Commissioner in Dhaka David Preston gave the assurance when he met Environment and Forest Minister Shahjahan Siraj at his office here yesterday.
The envoy appreciated the minister for imposing a ban on use of polythene shopping bags and taking steps for controlling air pollution and destruction of hills.
Referring to the city's air pollution, the Environment Minister said the government has taken steps to convert two-stroke engine auto-rickshaws into CNG ones and import four-stroke auto-rickshaws to save the country air pollution.
He apprised the envoy of different government initiatives, including installation of catalytic converters and diesel particulate filters in motor vehicles to control air pollution.
Issues relating to relocation of tanneries to a suitable place, river pollution, traffic congestion, arsenic problem, and lack of pure drinking water in adjoining areas of Dhaka also came up in the meeting for discussion.
