Reinstatement of 9 BSS journalists demanded

The journalists of the Bangladesh Sangbad Samstha (BSS) demanded immediate reinstatement of their colleagues who were sacked recently.

In a meeting, the BSS unit of DUJ (Dhaka Union of Journalist) expressed deep anguish over the sacking of nine journalists and termed the act of the present management of BSS politically motivated.

The meeting was held at the newsroom of the agency yesterday.

The newsmen also expressed concern that the BSS management has made a list of 45 more journalists to put them under the axe.

Presided over by Ajit Kumar Sarker, BSS unit chief, the meeting was addressed by M Shajahan Mian, Kazi Maksudul Hasan, Azizul Islam Bhuiyan, Delwar Hossain, Harun Habib, Sayed Afzal Hossain, Masud Chowdhury, Amirul Momenin and Akhter Ahmad Khan, Kazi Rafique and Molah Jalal.

PSF workshop on Women's Day

Palli Shishu Foundation of Bangladesh (PSF) organised a day-long workshop with the staff of head office and regional offices at its office in the city on Friday to mark the International Women's Day, says a press release.

Educate people in preventive health

President A Q M Badruddoja Chowdhury yesterday urged all, especially children, to exercise preventive health practices to beat a range of diseases.

"Prevention is better and less expensive than cure," he said.

He also called on political and socio-cultural organisations to educate people in preventive health to build a healthy nation.

"Social workers, teachers and union parishad chairmen and members should be involved in spreading health education messages," he said, adding "We need a healthy nation to compete in the changed world."

The President said this while he was inaugurating a daylong health clinic, organised by Doctors Association of Bangladesh (DAB) and Gazipur district and Kapasia upazila administrations, at Capasia Pilot High School Ground as the chief guest.

The inaugural function was also addressed by former jute minister Brig General (Retd) A S M

Hannan Shah, Fazul Haq Milon, MP, and Gazipur DAB president Dr Mazharul Alam.

He stressed the need for inclusion of health education in school and college curricula to make children, the future of the nation, aware of various health hazards.

He said doctors should not show laxity in treating patients. Their responsibilities do not end with giving mere prescriptions, he said, adding they should give the patients medicine, suggest necessary diets and spell out preventive healthcare measures.

The President urged all to take proper preventive measures to face dengue, malaria, tuberculosis, arsenic contamination and other health scourges.

Forty doctors, including specialists in ear, nose and throat (ENT), paediatrics, orthopaedics, surgery, medicine and gynaecology, are treating patients at the health clinic for free.

President Chowdhury, himself a renowned physician, also attended some serious cases.
