# **Draw suffices Eng captain**

England's Test attack took just two wickets as the game against Canterbury petered out into a tame draw Saturday, but captain Nasser Hussain declared himself pleased with his side's performance in the final warm-up game of the tour.

Craig White and Ashley Giles were the only England bowlers to taste success as a flat batting pitch made it a tough day for the tourists at Hagley Oval as Canterbury reached 175 for two.

England had earlier declared their first innings at 432 for nine with White extending his overnight score to 73.

A lead of 220 gave England the chance of victory but their bowlers were unable to make any headway against a Canterbury side happy to bat for the draw

Openers Robbie Frew and Shannon Stewart added a painstaking 112 for the first wicket off nearly 50 overs as England toiled in the field

Stewart was dropped on nought by Ashley Giles at gully off Andy Caddick, with the fielder calling the batsman back after admitting he arounded the ball.
