## Book reading competition: 4,500 students receive prizes

Biswa Sahitya Kendra gave away prizes to 4,500 school students who took part in the 'Book reading competition-2001' during the three-day long prize giving ceremony.

Yesterday was the concluding day of the ceremony held at the Shawkat Osman auditorium of the Public Library in the city.

A total of 24,000 students studying between class six and ten in 100 schools of the city took part in the competition organised by the Biswa Sahitya Kendra.

Twenty students were also presented with books worth Tk 1000 through lottery at the ceremony. Novelist Imdadul Huq Milon, magician Jewel Aich, economist Dr. Ataur Rahman and president of Biswa Sahitya Kendra Abdullah Abu Syed spoke at the function.

He said the present government has ensured the enrolment of more students in post-graduation degree course to increase the number of specialist doctors in the country.

"For the first time the present government has launched MD-course and it is going to introduce Diploma in Anaesthesiology course in different medical colleges to meet the shortage of specialist doctors and anaesthesiologists," he said while addressing 19th Annual Conference of the Bangladesh Society of Anaesthesiologists (BSA) at BIAM auditorium here.

Referring to the advancement of anaesthesiology, one of the most important department of medical science the minister said complicated operations of brain, heart and liver are being possible due to development of anaesthesiology.

"But due to shortage of anaesthesiologists, emergency and general operations in the country are being impeded endangering life of numerous patients," he said.

The minister said the BNP during its previous tenure had set up Intensive Care Unit (ICU) at Dhaka Medical College, PG Hospital and National Institute of Cardio-Vascular disease.

Measures were underway to set up ICU unit at all medical colleges, he added.

Presided over by BSA president Dr M Khalilur Rahman the function was addressed by State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Aman Ullah Aman, Vice-Chancellor of BSMMU Prof. MA Hadi, secretary general of the society Dr. Wahiduddin Mahmud and chairman of the conference committee Dr. AKM Azizul Hoq.

## 'Ctg port to be modernised'

The government will take all possible measures to modernise the Chittagong Seaport, raising its standard to the international level.

Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman told this while replying to a question in the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday.

"If we fail to do so, Chittagong port will die down and the ships will change their course to other neighbouring ports," he said.

Earlier replying to the main question, the finance minister said Chittagong port earned a revenue income of Tk 7,428.64 crore during the 2000-2001 fiscal year, up by Tk 1,341.48 crore from the previous year's income.

Replying to other supplementaries raised by treasury bench members including Hafizuddin
