

## 2nd round of NID observed

UNB, Dhaka

The 2nd round of 10th National Immunisation Day was observed across the country yesterday with a view to building a polio-free Bangladesh.

Volunteers from UNICEF, WHO, IOCH, JAICA and Rotary International as well as health workers, teachers, students and NGO activists took part in the vaccination programme.

Nearly two crore under-5 children were given polio vaccines at 1.20 lakh centres across the country.

As part of the worldwide pro-

gramme to eradicate polio, the National Immunisation Day is being observed in the country since 1995.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Dr Khandaker Mosharraf Hossain formally inaugurated the programme administering two drops of vaccine to some children at the head office of EPI in the city on Saturday.

Yesterday State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Amanullah Aman administered two drops of polio vaccine to some children at Matruj High School.

Labour and Employment Min-

ister Abdullah Al Noman took part in the programme at Fuad Al Khatib Hospital.

Mayor Mohamad Hanif also administered polio vaccines to some children in the city yesterday.

Speaking on the occasion, the mayor urged the people to come forward to eradicate polio from the country through active participation in the programme.

Chakma City Corporation through its 25 mobile teams comprising over 8000 volunteers vaccinated under-5 children at 1.700 centres in the city.



## PDB snapped 12,637 lines last month

BSS, Dhaka

Power Development Board (PDB) snapped 12,637 electric lines and realised Tk about 3.6 crore in a drive against bill defaulters and illegal users in a countrywide drive last month.

Of the disconnected lines in all of PDB's eight transmission zones, 11,622 belonged to those who defaulted on Tk 12.26 crore bills and 1,015 to those who used power illegally, said a press release.

Later, 3,960 lines were restored according to rules after realisation of Tk 3 crore 35 lakh and 64 thousand.

And Tk 27 lakh and 26 thousand lines were realised in fines from illegal power users and 386 cases were filed against them.

Of the PDB zones Chittagong topped the list of power defaulters where 3,035 lines were cut for outstanding bills amounting to Tk 4.5 crore. Of the disconnected lines, 687 were restored after realisation of Tk 67 lakh.

In Khulna zone, 2,671 lines were snapped for defaulting on Tk 1.98 crore bills. Of the disconnected lines, 1,090 were restored after realisation of Tk 62 lakh.



In Rajshahi zone, 1,706 lines were snapped for outstanding bills amounting to Tk 1.56 crore, of which 681 were restored later with the realisation of Tk 52 lakh.

In Comilla zone, 600 lines were cut for defaulting on Tk 1.08 crore bills. Of those, 297 lines were restored and Tk 58.98 lakh was realised.
