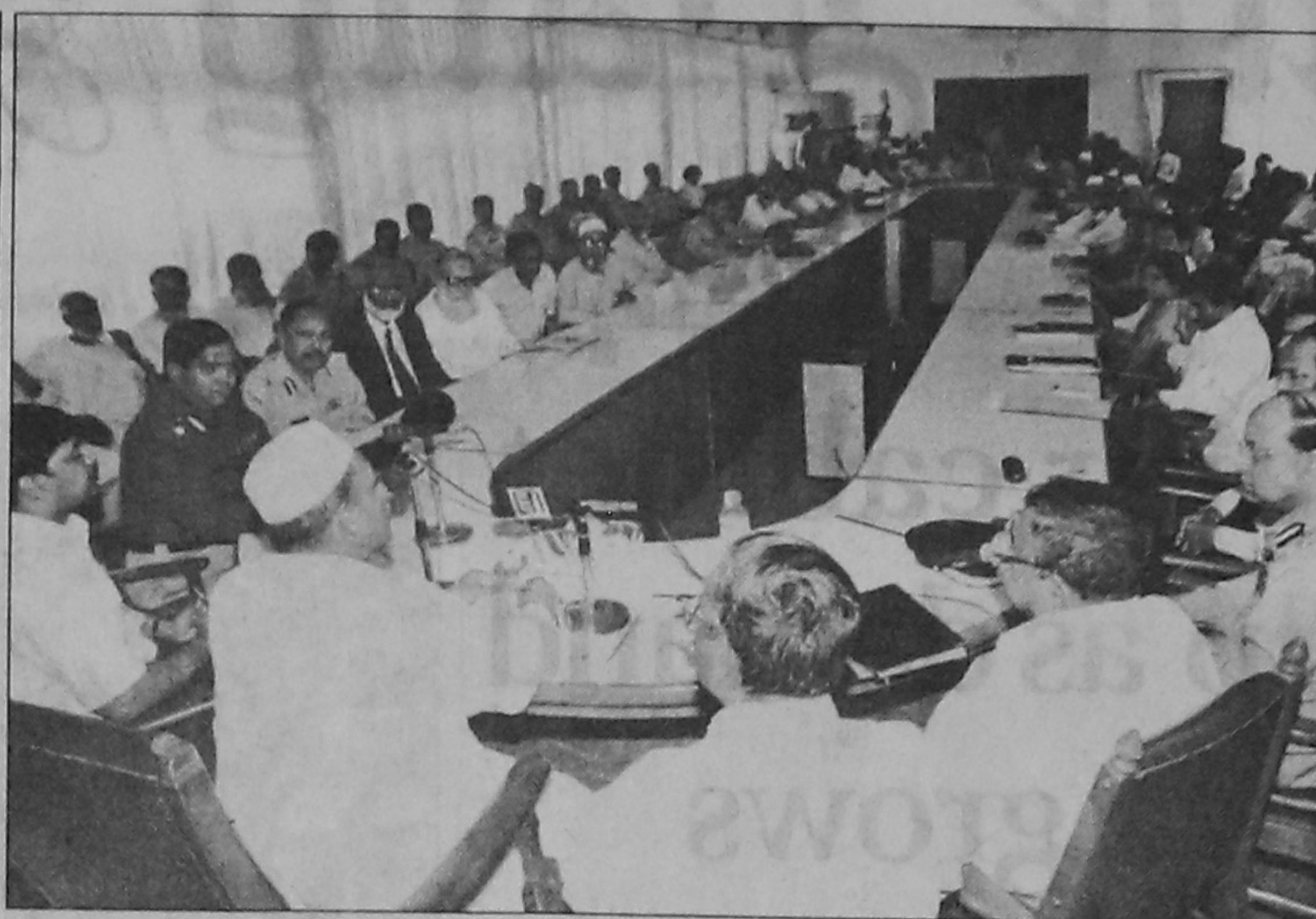


Sustainable development Dhaka meet from March 18

Default loans of NCBs stand at Tk 12227.07cr

Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman on Sunday informed the parliament that the default loans of the nationalised commercial banks (NCBs) now stood at Tk 12,227.07 crore.

To realise the default loans, certain steps have been taken, he said. The steps include formation of taskforces in all commercial banks headed by their respective managing directors and a high-powered taskforce has been formed in the Bangladesh Bank with a deputy governor as its head to monitor those taskforces.
