Repeat offenders will face level two charges and could be punished by a fine of a full match fee and suspension. Level four breaches, which would include threats and violence, will incur a minimum ban of five Tests or 10 one-day internationals, with a maximum of a life ban.

Paul Condon, director of the ICC anti-corruption unit, told a media briefing that international cricket had been free of corruption for the past year. He said he was confident next year's World Cup in South Africa would be played "entirely on merit"

The board meeting will be followed by a meeting of the Cricket Committee - Playing, under the chairmanship of former Indian Test batting great Sunil Gavaskar.

The most far-reaching outcome could be an extension of the use of technology to include an option for on-field umpires to refer any decisions to a television umpire for review

If adopted, the new system will be launched during the ICC Champions Trophy tournament in September.

The cricket committee will also discuss the future use of bonus points in one-day international tournaments and a proposal for meetings after Test matches between captains, umpires and match referees.

A four-day workshop will be held near Cape Town from March 21 to 24 for the newly-appointed full-time panels of five match referees and . eiaht umpires.
