No Cairns for NZ in Asia

All-rounder Chris Cairns has been ruled out of next month's one-day competition in Sharjah and also New Zealand's tour of Pakistan after tearing a tendon in his right knee.

Cairns, 31, injured his right patella while diving in the field on the first day of the first Test against England in Christchurch and New Zealand coach Denis Aberhart said on Friday his recovery would take some time.

The all-rounder had previously been carrying a back injury and only returned to international duty for New Zealand's tour to Australia late last year.

New Zealand tour West Indies immediately after the Pakistan series in May but, by then, Cairns is scheduled to be playing English countcricket with Nottinghamshire.

Nottinghamshire, however, are looking for a possible replacement for Cairns in case the New Zealander fails to regain full fitness in time to honour his contact.

Australia captain Steve Waugh has told reporters to get their priorities in order after arriving home to face questions about the mounting speculation that his outstanding Öest career is over.

Waugh, 36, who has led Australia to 3-0 and 2-1 victories in home and away Test series against South Africa, has been dropped from the national one-day side.

There has been media speculation that Ricky Ponting, his replacement as one-day skipper, will also captain Australia in next month's two-Test series in Zimbabwe.

"I find this pretty amazing today. We've just won the (two) series 5-1 but no one's asked me about that. the priorities are wrong somewhere," Waugh told reporters at Sydney airport after returning from South Africa.

"Australian cricket's going really well. We've beaten the supposed No.2 side in the world 5-1 and I haven't been asked one question about it, so thanks guys.'


