The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) in various currencies towards the cost of BSRTI Strengthening Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for procurement of various items listed under SI.2

2. Bangladesh Sericulture Research & Training Institute, Rajshahi now invites sealed bids under National Competitive Bidding Procedure (NCB) from eligible bidders for the supply of:
a) Refrigerator (Package # SRG-5), b) Air Conditioner (Package # SRG-6), c) Computerized Electronic Balance (Package # SRG-9), d) Humidifier and De-humidifier (Package # SRG-11), e) Irrigation Pump (Package # SRG-14), f) Soil PH meter and PH meter (Package # SRG-23), g) Compound Microscope (Binocular, Monocular) and Binocular Stereo Lab. Submission of income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate according to the provision of section 107 of Income Tax Ordinance, 1984 for foreign nationals at the time of leaving Bangladesh.

Government has decided to implement the provision of submission of income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate for foreign nationals leaving Bangladesh according to the provision of section 107 of Income Tax Ordinance, 1984. The Immigration Authority shall be responsible for checking the income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate for the foreign nationals at the time of their departure from Bangladesh. A press release has been issued on 11/3/2002 in this regard. For general information of all concerned, the procedures and formalities for obtaining income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate are given below:

The following foreign nationals are not required to submit income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate before the immigration authority:

- (i) All members of diplomatic, trade or commercial missions appointed by foreign governments, trade commissioners and consul de carrier and all full time employees of such diplomatic missions, trade commissioners and consular officers;
- (ii) All officers and employees of foreign government visiting Bangladesh on duty;
- (iii) The wives and dependants of persons mentioned in serial No. (i) & (ii).
- (iv) All foreign nationals working as officers/staffs of International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Islamic Development Bank, Asian Development Bank, European Union, Organization of Islamic Conference, South Asian Association for Regional Co-operation and United Nations & its affiliates;
- (v) All persons below the age of 18 (eighteen) years;
- (vi) All persons who have not spent more than ninety days at a time in Bangladesh;
- (vii) All persons who have not spent more than ninety days in any financial year in Bangladesh;
- (viii) Woman who gives a declaration to the effect that she is wholly dependent upon her husband, parent or guardian and has no independent source of income;
- (ix) Foreign technicians working in any Export Processing Zone in Bangladesh for three years from his/her arrival in Bangladesh;
- (x) Foreign nationals working in the privet sector power generation in Bangladesh for three years from his/her arrival in Bangladesh

Where to apply for income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate:

The foreign nationals will have to apply to the following income tax offices for obtaining income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate:

(i)	Where the applicant is an existing assessee, the application is to be addressed to the Deputy Commissioner of Taxes where he is presently assessed;
(ii)	Where the applicant is not an existing assessee, the application is to be addressed to the following Deputy Commissioner of Taxes;
(a)	For persons located in Dhaka District Deputy Commissioner of Taxes Companies Circle-17 Taxes Zone-6, Dhaka. Address: 3/2 Bijoy Nagar, Dhaka, Phone: 02-9354273
(b)	For persons located in Chittagong District Deputy Commissioner of Taxes Companies Circle-1 Taxes Zone-1, Chittagong. Address: CGO Building No. 1 Ground Floor, Agrabad C/A, Chittagong Phone: 031-723716
(c)	For persons located in Sylhet District Deputy Commissioner of Taxes Sylhet Circle-1 Taxes Zone-Sylhet. Address: 151, Nawab Road Kazol Shah, Sylhet. Phone: 0821-716411
(d)	For persons located in Jessore District Deputy Commissioner of Taxes Jessore Circle-1 Taxes Zone-Khulna. Address: 260, Shah Abdul Karim Road Kharki, Jessore. Phone: 0421-3556
(iii)	For persons located in other districts, the concerned Deputy Commissioner of Taxes of that district.

Foreign nationals leaving Bangladesh will have to apply for income tax clearance certificate/income tax exemption certificate in the following prescribed form:
