Federer halts Hewitt

Switzerland's Roger Federer upset top seed Leyton Hewitt 6-3, 6-4 to reach the final of the 6.345 million-dollar Tennis Masters Series tournament here, handing the world number one his first defeat on American soil in 23 matches.

It was another impressive hardcourt performance by the 12th-seeded Swiss, who has not dropped a set or had his serve broken on the way to his first career Masters final.

Federer now meets defending champion Andre Agassi, who claimed his first career win over Marcelo Rios, and a place in the final for the seventh time, when the Chilean suddenly retired with their match level at 6-7, 6-4.

Unbeaten in the United States since his U.S. Open victory last year and riding a two-tournament winning streak, Hewitt lacked his usual tenacity after an exhausting three-set quarterfinal win over Russian Marat Safin on Thursday.

Hewitt's four matches going into the semifinal averaged two hours while Federer disposed of his opponents in an average of 57 minutes.

Federer, who had lost to the Australian in four of their five previous meetings, had only one early break in each set but that was all the edge the 20-year-old Swiss needed with

Hewitt unable to convert his three break opportunities.

Having received treatment on his lightly-wrapped knee early in the match, Rios had given no hint of any distress until he calmly rose from his seat, walked over and shook Agassi's hand before leaving the court under a shower of boos and whistles.

Caddick clipped the top of Richardson's off-stump in the fifth over of the day for five leaving the Kiwis at 12 for one.

Fleming, promoted to number three in the order following the elevation of Vincent to opener, lasted nine balls before he became a victim of Hoggard for five.

Hoggard had a big shout for lbw on Fleming, which was turned down by New Zealand umpire Doug Cowie, and the next ball he played to Mark Ramprakash at short-leg.

Vincent was deceived by Caddick's swing and was bowled between bat and pad for 10 leaving the Kiwis tottering at 17 for 3 off 8.1 overs.
