SHISUK regretted the wrong information given to the press on April 3 about the number of Bangladeshi workers in Malaysia.



Power generation without fuel

UNB, Dhaka

A London-based Bangladeshi scientist has invented mechanism of nonstop power generation at the least possible cost without any external fuel.

Dr Abdul Khaleque, famous for his "Swarna" fertiliser, made the disclosure about his latest invention, currently pending with International Patent Office in Geneva, at a press meet here yesterday.

Forum for Energy Reporters, Bangladesh (FERB) arranged the press meet at the National Press Club to let Bangladesh as well as the world know about the revolutionary invention.

The device could be used to generate incessant power using the "natural force" which would be multiplied under an in-built mechanism of the system.

"The natural force will be used

as rotational motion power with certain unit coming back to the source continuing power supply without any fuel use," said Dr Khaleque.

The 58-year-old scientist took his master degree in Biochemistry from Dhaka University.

Dr Khaleque, who demonstrated his invention in Bangladesh, said his device could be used to set up power plants and run vessels, including small vehicles depending on its engineering design.

A fellow of Royal Institute of Chemistry and member of British Institute of Biology, Dr Khaleque has so far received patents of his 14 discoveries. Of them, 11 came from World Intellectual Property Organisation of UN.

FERB President Badiul Alam and Executive Director Mollah Amzad Hossain were present at the press meet.
