

Israeli incursion continues unabated: US must rein in Sharon



UICK sequence of unfortunate and horrible events marked the Jewish Passover and also Easter in the Middle East. In reply to Israeli military's long siege of Palestinian areas, killing of Palestinians, confining of President Arafat in Ramallah etc., there were several attacks by Palestinian suicide bombers in Israel proper. The last notable bombing was at a hotel in Netanya, Israel where about 200 Israelis assembled for Passover dinner and the Hamas suicide bomber entered the hotel dining room and detonated his bomb killing 21 Israelis. This was the worst suicide bombing so far carried out by Hamas, and other Palestinian radicals. Israelis called it a Passover massacre. This was quickly condemned by President Arafat of Palestinian Authority though he has been under virtual house arrest under Sharon's order for the last three months in Ramallah and said, "We are against killing of civilians on both sides." President Bush who was in his Ranch at Texas and was reportedly relaxing with his family and playing with his dog obviously felt disturbed and called the attack "cold-blooded killing" and said such "callous" acts must stop. Obviously, many other countries of the world
