


Bertil Lintner, a Bangkokbased stringer and guest writer of the Review, obtained visa from the Deputy High Commission of Bangladesh in Calcutta, hiding his identity to visit Dhaka on an 'anti-Bangladesh news fixing mission,'

Lintner, a Swedish national, also wrote as a staff reporter the

same anti-Bangladesh piece in the Wall Street Journal, a sister organisation of the Review, both owned by Dow-Jones, a financial publishing firm in New York.

Bangladesh government could not find the records of his 'hate Bangladesh mission trip' initially because he hid his identity, the official said.

In his visa application form, he gave his identity as an educationist based in Thailand.
