



Rule nisi on govt, BSS STAFF CORRESPONDENT

The High Court yesterday issued a rule nisi on the government and the management of Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS) to show cause why the BSS employees service regulation 1995 and the termination order on Mohammad Abu Naser Rajib, a staff reporter of the news agency, would not be declared illegal.

A division bench comprising Justice MA Matin and Marzi-ul-Haq also directed the BSS management to maintain status quo regarding the termination order.

The court order came following a writ challenging the BSS Karmachari Chakuri Probidhanmala (service rule) and the termination of Rajib.

Dr. Kamal Hossain moving the petition on behalf Abu Naser Rajib, said the petitioner was terminated under a void service regulation and therefore his termination order has no legal effect.
