Mustakim was rescued from the premises of the Passport Office at Agargaon in the city four months ago. It is suspected that the miscreants left him after bringing him there for trafficking.
The minor boy can not say anything about his identity except his name Manglu and home district Rangpur.

Reserved seats for disabled in buses, trains

Every bus and train in the country will now have two reserved seats for the disabled.

Also, the visually impaired people will be allowed to travel in BRTC buses at half the normal ticket price all over the country.

Communications Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda announced the measures at a discussion meeting on "Accessible Transport System for Disabled People" organised by the Action on Disability and Development

(ADD) at a city hotel yesterday.

At the discussion meeting, the minister also inaugurated the reserved seats for disabled people by putting up special stickers that read "Reserved Seats for Disabled People" on a BRTC bus and a Nirapad coach.

Addressing the meeting, the Communication Minister said that the disabled people can be an asset for the country provided they get the adequate support and opportunity.

He urged the disabled people to take advantage of the facilities

the government has been providing for their benefit.

ASM Mosharrif Hossain, programme manager of ADD, in his keynote speech, said the mobility of the disabled people in public sector is their right.

Among others, Taimur Alam Khondokar, chairman of BRTC, Murtaza Hossain Munshi, DG, Social Welfare Directorate, Borje Mattson, Ambassador of Sweden, and representatives from Bus Owners' Associations and Drivers and Transport Owners Associations were present at the meeting.

Call to protect rights of adolescents, women

Education Minister Dr. Osman Farruk yesterday underscored the need for involving the adolescents and women in the mainstream social and economic activities to achieve sustainable development.

The future of the country depends on the adolescents, so they should be groomed up properly, he said and called for ensuring their rights to education, access to healthcare facilities and their se-

curity.

The minister also called upon the Opposition, NGOs and civil society to supplement the government's efforts to protect their rights.

Dr. Osman Farruk was speaking as chief guest at the inaugural session of a national workshop on 'Adolescent Development Programme (ADP)', organised by the USC Canada Bangladesh (USCC-B) in association with the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA), at the LGED Bhaban Auditorium in the city.

The minister said, "The government has given priority to the education sector initiating various promotional activities like 'food for education' especially for the underprivileged adolescents in the rural areas."

Ashrukana Das, Chairperson, USCC-B National Advisory Council, chaired the inaugural function while Kevin Smith, Acting Head of Aid, CIDA, and Ann Thomson, Executive Director, USC Canada, spoke as special guests.

Kevin Smith said that CIDA is committed to fulfil the basic needs of the deprived adolescents of the country as a development partner

of Bangladesh.

"CIDA will continue its assistance to the Adolescent Development Programme (ADP) in Bangladesh," he assured.

Ashrukana Das said that USCC-B is working in the country with the philosophy to alleviate poverty and strengthen the capability of civil society replicating the experiences of both the government and the NGOs.

A total of 35400 poor and illiterate adolescents (11-17 age group) are involved with ADP throughout the country.

They are provided with family development foundation training, basic education and vocational skill training so that they can protect themselves from different social vices.

Resist conspiracy against movement: Samad Azad
